



Andrew Tompkins Memorial College Scholarship Award



Andrew Joseph Tompkins was born to Diana and Paul Tompkins on Easter Sunday, April 12, 1998. He is survived by two sisters, Marion and Julia. He received the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, Holy Communion, and Confirmation at our family parish, Queen of Angels Church in Alpine, California. He was very active in our parish as a member of the children's choir, a long-time altar server, a member of the 412 Church Youth Ministry Group, and he attended the Steubenville Youth Conferences throughout his high school years.

Andrew graduated from Granite Hills High School in 2016 and attended the University of La Verne (ULV) on an academic scholarship to study business marketing. He received the Knights of Columbus scholarship award for the two years he attended ULV and was grateful to the Knights Council for the financial support. Andrew had a passion for learning. He was an Honor Student and an accomplished swimmer and diver in high school and college.

Unfortunately, Andrew was diagnosed with cancer in his second year of college and was forced to suspend his studies while he had surgery and went through chemotherapy for several months. After a very tough battle, the Lord called him home on September 22, 2019 at the age of 21. While Andrew's time at ULV was short, he completed enough units to receive his Associate of Arts degree (posthumous). He was a natural born student and loved school and university life. He would be honored to know that this scholarship fund is now named after him. Indeed, his family is honored that Andrew's memory will live on through all students who go off to college with big hopes and dreams and remain strong in the Catholic faith.

Scholarship Fundamentals

We will present scholarships to practicing Catholic Queen of Angels students. Eligible students are high school seniors or current full-time university, college, or trade school students.

Scholarships will be used to fund full-time tuition at an accredited school for the 2022-2023 academic year.

Presentation of scholarships will be after a Mass this summer. Attendance is encouraged.

Applications will be available in the Church office and on the Parish website.

Scholarship awards will be based upon Academics, Community Service, Financial Need, Activities / Leadership, Church Service, and Future Goals. Applications will also include Interviews and Letters of Recommendation.

The following documents provide the applicant with the complete package for applying. Additionally, the score sheet that the Scholarship Committee will use to determine the winners is attached for reference. Lastly, a survey is attached. Please fill out the survey to help us better serve future applicants.

Application Eligibility

Applicants must be a practicing Catholic and member of Queen of Angels Parish.

Applicants must be a senior in a Catholic, Public, Charter or accredited home high school or a full-time student at an accredited college or trade school. Scholarship winners will maintain full-time status.

Electronic applications must be complete and **EMAILED NO LATER THAN 11:59PM ON MAY 31ST** to be considered. All applications should be emailed to jwoestman703@gmail.com

Applications will only be considered if fully completed. Lack of any required information or document may remove application from selection process.

Scholarship winners will be required to provide official documentation of enrollment from the registrar's office from their respective school.

General Information

Awards will be made by the Scholarship Committee based on applications and interview scores. The decisions of the Scholarship Committee shall be final.

The recipients may be asked to address the Parish at least one weekend (all three Masses) to encourage other students to apply for higher education and to apply for our scholarships.

Number of awardees and scholarship monetary amounts will be determined by the Scholarship Committee on an annual basis. Our goal is to most effectively help our Parish students.

Funds will be forwarded to the educational institutions where the recipients are enrolled as full-time students. Funds are then released by the institution to cover costs of tuition and books in accordance with the school's policies. No funds will be directly distributed to the students.

Failure of any recipient to fulfill all obligations and eligibility requirements as set forth may result in forfeiture of the scholarship.

Scholarship winners will be required to provide official documentation of enrollment from the registrar's office from their respective school.
