PASTOR'S PAGE

Friends,

I wanted to take the time this weekend to explain what I hope we will be able to accomplish, and also what I anticipate NOT accomplishing, with our Faith Formation program this coming academic year.

First, the “not accomplishing” part. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 2223) states that, “Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children,” which includes their education in the faith. This belief is restated throughout the prayers of the Church. More than that, it is something I hope every parent actually wants: to be the first teachers of their own children, especially when it comes those things that are most important in life, such as love, faith, and family. All of which brings me to what our faith formation program will NOT do: it will NOT be able to replace the instruction that your children are receiving at home. If you were to drop your child off at school and then never reinforce anything that they learned there, your child would likely do poorly in school, and that is with upwards of 40 hours of instruction each week. So we should not be surprised that a commensurate level of effort is required to teach morals and faith in God when children are usually only at church for 1-2 hours each week. No matter how good a teacher is, they cannot replace you, the parents, as the first, and hopefully greatest, teachers of your children. You can and must have a vital role in their spiritual formation, just as you play a vital role in every other aspect of their growth and maturation.

What I hope we WILL be able to do is field classes for as many age groups as possible to reinforce what is being taught at home and to help all of our young people, regardless of where they are spiritually when they show up for the first time, encounter Christ so that their faith becomes real for them. I also hope that we will be able to make the journey of faith one that families become more comfortable traveling *together*. To that end, I have decided to hold all faith formation classes this year on Sundays in between the two morning Masses (0915-1015) so that we can also provide a catechetical / Bible study course for parents, who will be expected to attend, as well as other interested adults, during that time while they wait for the children. If we can field enough volunteers, I hope to eventually provide nursery care for our youngest parishioners so that parents can attend their “class” without worry. The reasons I have decided to use the somewhat more Protestant “Sunday School” model this year are as follows:

1. It works.
2. It offers parents a way to learn more about their faith, giving them tools to use and empowering them to be better teachers at home.
3. It helps build community over time. If I go to “Sunday School” (for lack of a better term) in between the two morning Masses, then I am far more likely to run into, and develop friendships with, people who usually go to a different Mass than me.
4. You only have to convince your kids to get in the car to go to church once each week.
5. If it ends up being a failed experiment, we can blame COVID and start over next year.

While those final two reasons are admittedly a bit tongue-in-cheek, I truly believe that this will work if we give it a chance. Thank you to everyone who has already reached out and offered to help in one capacity or another. I will be contacting you by the end of this week (September 3rd/4th) to set up a catechist and volunteer meeting. For those of you who may want to help but have not contacted me yet, please do so this week (frdexner@queenofangels.org).

Whether you are hoping to register your child for faith formation, or are just interested in the idea of an adult Bible study to learn more about your faith, stay tuned for more details in coming weeks in the announcements and here in the bulletin, as I hope to kick off all faith formation classes again in October. One of the best parts about our faith is that there is always more to learn, and more ways to encounter our Lord. I look forward to encountering him with all of you.

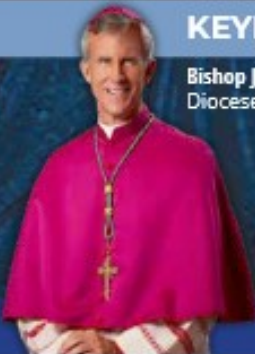
