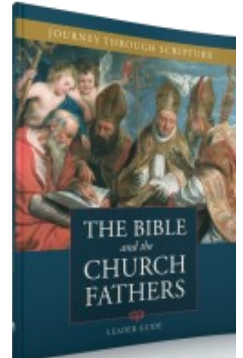

Registration forms are available on the table in the main entry of the church or the parish office. Registration allows us to communicate and effectively provide for your needs. It is necessary for baptism, marriage, and godparent or sponsor certification.



PASTOR'S PAGE

Friends,

As has been hinted at in the announcements for the past couple weeks, the parish will be having training for all liturgical ministers throughout this coming month. This is to both “refresh” returning ministers after our year-long COVID hiatus, and to provide an opportunity for new ministers to join these ministries and participate in our parish family. I am asking that everyone who wants to be a part in one of these ministries, even if you have been serving in that capacity for a long time, attend one of the provided dates for your respective ministry of choice. I will be generating new ministry rosters from those who attend, so if you want to participate in one of these ministries, you will have to either show up on one of the designated dates, or talk with me individually so that we can make alternate arrangements for you to receive the same information that will get passed on to everyone else. While most training blocks are scheduled for a whole hour (24-hour time), the majority will not take that long. The dates and times of the training blocks are as follows:



Altar Servers: Wed, 08 Sep 1700-1800 / Thu, 16 Sep 1700-1800 / Tues, 28 Sep 1700-1800

Eucharistic Ministers: Thu, 09 Sep 1700-1800 / Fri, 17 Sep 1700-1800 / Wed, 29 Sep 1700-1800

Lectors: Fri, 10 Sep 1700-1800 / Tues, 14 Sep 1700-1800 / Thu, 30 Sep 1700-1800

Musicians: Sat, 25 Sep 1645-1715 / Sun, 26 Sep 0930-1000

Sacristans/Linens: Sat, 18 Sep 1645-1715 / Sun, 19 Sep 0930-1000

Ushers: Sun, 12 Sep 0930-1000

A quick word on some special exceptions: For the altar server training, at least one parent or guardian must be present for the duration of the training. At the meeting for Eucharistic Ministers we will discuss the possibility of restarting homebound ministry to the sick. Daily Mass lectors are also expected to attend at least one session of lector training.

Additionally, I am asking that individuals only sign up for one ministry at a time. We will be introducing 2 year “term limits,” for lack of a better term, for every ministry except for the altar servers so that you can, over the course of a few years, try your hand at several different ministries. It is generally helpful to focus on one kind of ministry at a time, rather than take on several all at once. Instituting term limits has the added benefit of helping us avoid one of the deadliest poisons to parish life: cliques.

I understand that this may feel like a break from what we are used to, but coming out of a year of quarantine and relative isolation, I think it is a good time to hit the “reset” button when it comes to how we approach serving the Lord at the altar, in whatever capacity we are called. Thank you for your understanding, and thank you in advance for giving your time and talent to Jesus and to our parish.

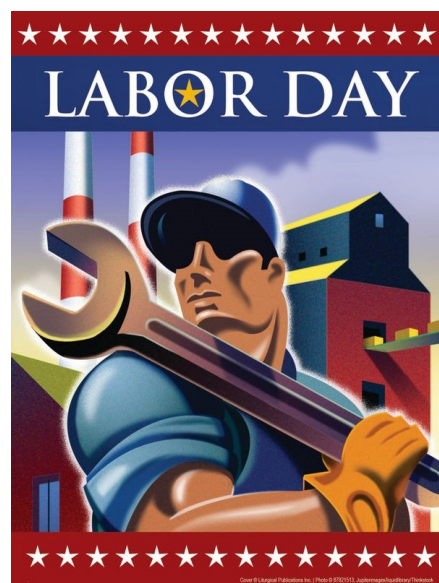
