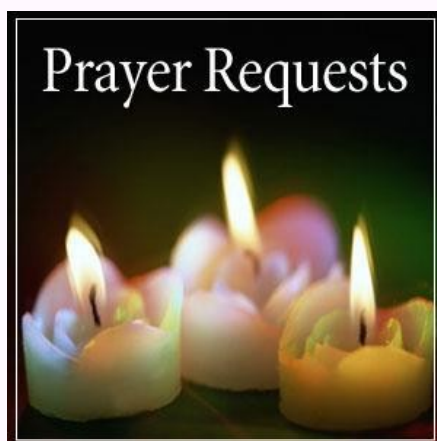

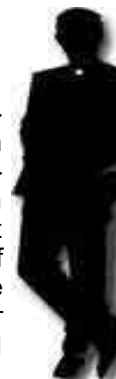

PASTOR'S PAGE

Friends,

This year the feasts of Saint Monica and Saint Augustine fall on this weekend, so we are not afforded the opportunity that we usually would have to celebrate and remember the story of their amazing faith in Christ. And it is an amazing story. While most Christians remember Augustine very well – I believe that all of us on some level appreciate how much he struggled to follow the Lord when he was younger and find consolation in his later conversion – really it's impossible to tell the story of one of them without telling the story of both, or for that matter, without also telling the story of one of their best mutual friends: Saint Ambrose. That's right! Three of the greatest saints of the 4th Century all knew each other well and were close friends! In fact, the expression, "when in Rome, do as the Romans," actually comes from a letter written by Saint Ambrose to Saint Augustine about – are you ready for this? – the practice of fasting! Each of these three friends, in their own journeys of faith towards and with the Lord Jesus, teach us something powerful about God's grace.



Augustine famously did everything he could to avoid God for much of his early life, but although he was extremely successful by the world's standard of measurement, he found himself still in search of something more. He finally found what he was looking for after befriending Bishop Ambrose, and the long-awaited answer to his mother's prayers were realized when he was baptized into the faith. He wrote *Confessions* – which might be the first real autobiography ever written – detailing the gritty details of his own journey to faith. But just as he was zealous in avoiding God for many years, after discovering God he pursued the truth and goodness he had found with the same energy and zeal. Augustine is an example of how the greatest sinners often become the greatest saints, because his primary mistake was not want of trying, but simply trying for the wrong things, and after discovering the Creator, Augustine, who applied so much time and energy to his sin, took that same enthusiasm and directed it towards God, the same God who had pursued him even when he was living in sin. This is not, incidentally, an invitation to sin greatly, but rather a word of hope for all who either struggle with great sin themselves or who are praying for a good friend or family member who is struggling.

And speaking of praying for others, Monica, Augustine's mother, teaches us about faithfulness in prayer, even in the midst of long-suffering, or if it looks like God is ignoring us and not answering our prayer. She prayed for the conversion of her son for years, but watched him deliberately move further and further away from her and from God. And then, perhaps when she least expected it... he came back. Monica was an incredible prayer warrior, someone who always persevered in her prayer, and God rewarded her faithfulness. Her love for her family and her constant prayers for her son's conversion are why Mother's Day is celebrated on Saint Monica's feast day in Italy, where she lived for a good portion of her adult life. And it is Monica whom we credit with Augustine's conversion, not their good mutual friend, Ambrose, even though it was Ambrose whose words finally got through to the wayward Augustine.

Ambrose, whose feast day falls in December instead of on back-to-back days in August like Monica and Augustine, was a friend of both. He encouraged Monica before her son came to faith, and he was patient with Augustine in his more circuitous journey. I think he may have been so patient with Augustine because he saw a bit of himself in the young man; after all, Ambrose himself, although more sincere and less wild than Augustine, had also put off making a decision to follow Christ for many years. He also knew that Augustine was too smart to remain apart from God if he was honest in his pursuit of wisdom. And although he was intentional in his friendship with Augustine and in the words he used to convince him of the truth, he also recognized that his role was not primarily to convert Augustine by himself, but to remain true to his own calling.

All three of these friends can teach us a great deal about ourselves, about our shared vocation to holiness, about the importance of family and friendship in helping us find Christ, about the necessity of prayer, and most of all, about God's incredible love for us. Saint Monica, Saint Augustine, and Saint Ambrose, pray for us!

MISSIONS

This weekend, August 27-28 Rev. Dr. Benedict Mwangi on behalf of Bishop James Maria Wainaina of Muranga Diocese (Kenya-East Africa) will be preaching at every Mass and sharing with us about the needs for the mission appeal for his diocese. There will be a second collection taken during Mass, and special envelopes for giving towards these needs will also be in the pews.

The Diocese of Muranga has 44 parishes that are run by 99 diocesan and 13 missionary priests all within an area of about 2,500 square miles. This diocese sponsors 12 religious congregations, one newly established congregation for women, two diocesan hospitals, one missionary hospital, and 14 dispensaries. They also serve many Primary and Secondary Schools, two Schools for the Deaf, and three Special Education Schools across two big districts.

The donations from the Mission Appeal will be used as follows:

- To feed, educate, and support financially 60 orphans.
- To help in the formation and education of 86 major seminarians
- To buy medicine for 100 children and 20 adults who are HIV positive in our two diocesan hospitals.

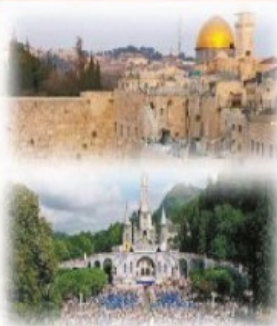
