PASTOR'S PAGE

Friends,

This past Friday the Church celebrated the feast of Saint Mary Magdalene, one of the most famous, or rather, infamous, saints in history. She is also probably the best known woman saint in all of Scripture other than the Blessed Mother, and from what I have seen, one of the most beloved saints that we have. Mary Magdalene moreover seems to be someone that both Catholics and Protestants feel that they can relate to because of her journey. While some of the stories about her may be apocryphal, what is certain about her is that Jesus delivered her from being possessed by seven demons. That leads to the very reasonable inference that she had an extremely colorful past, checkered with who-knows-what sins and failures. And yet... and yet Jesus saved her. And not only did he save her, his love for her so completely transformed her that she is one of the few people who managed to stay with Jesus all the way to the end on Good Friday, because her love for him was greater than her fear of the Romans. True, transformative love, which is the same kind of love that God wants to pour into our hearts and

lives, always has this effect: it conquers and casts out every fear. It was this same love for her Lord that caused Mary Magdalene to go to the tomb on Easter Sunday, and then to stay at the empty tomb's entrance after Peter and John left to rejoin the other disciples. And it was her incredible love for Jesus which is why he chose *her* among all of his disciples to be the first to see him again and to proclaim the mystery of the resurrection.

And in case you haven't guessed yet, yes, Mary Magdalene is one of my favorite saints too, and a big part of that is the powerful lesson that her life and faithfulness to Christ teaches us: that the love of God will always triumph, whether he is saving us from something too big and terrible for us to handle, consoling us from the Cross, or embracing us in moments of joy. God's love will always be there, it will always conquer, and it will cast out every fear. If he did that for Mary Magdalene, he can do it for us too.



Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples. "He said to them, "When you pray, say:

Father, hallowed be your name,

for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us,

"And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.

For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. What father among you would hand his son a snake when he asks for a fish? Or hand him a scorpion when he asks for an egg? If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your Children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"
