

Classes will meet on Sundays from 9:15 am-10:15 am in the hall.



Friends,

This weekend I would like to make a pitch for our Faith Formation program, and in particular make a request of the parents of our younger parishioners. As we have been announcing before Mass and posting in the bulletin since July, we are hoping to start Faith Formation (including sacramental prep) for children and the youth at the end of September. However, as of this weekend, just two weeks away from when we are hoping to start, there have been a grand total of 16 kids formally registered. This is, incidentally, about the same number as were registered two weeks before we started last year. By the end of the academic year, that number was over 37. In other words, more than half of the students were registered late. This cre-



ated a situation where teachers' classes in some cases doubled in size, and because we were limited by the number of teachers (we had, after all, planned on far fewer children being present each Sunday), some of the classes had to expand the age range they were teaching significantly. All of that was extremely unfair to our catechists and, frankly, also to all of the children in those classes. So what I am asking today is simply this: PARENTS, because this is on you, not your child, parents, if you are planning to register your child or teen for Faith Formation this year, PLEASE complete and submit the registration form (found by the entrance of the church, on the church webpage, and in an abbreviated form in the bulletin) by Monday, September 19. That should give the teachers and me enough time to finish planning and contact you about details before we hopefully - and I am at this point emphasizing the word hopefully - start on Sunday, September 25. You may drop the form off in the collection basket over the weekend or at the office during the week. I hope that this does not come across as petulant, but I would like to avoid a repeat of what happened last year. And while we're discussing this, it's worth remembering that at some point the spiritual formation of our children, as well as our own, has to be important enough to us to take it seriously. This is a good chance to do that. Thank you for hearing me out, and thanks to everyone who has done so much already as we try to make this year of Faith Formation and sacramental prep a reality. I will see you in the Eucharist.




DIOCESAN SYNOD
