



# **PASTOR'S PAGE**

# Friends,

This weekend I would like to ask you to pray for our youth. Our teenage candidates for Confirmation are on retreat this weekend (with a couple other parishes due to the size of our group). Please pray that they encounter Jesus Christ in a new and incredible way. Please pray that God touches their hearts so that they can know how beloved they are in His eyes. Most of all, though, please pray that they hear Him call each of them by name as He confirms His choice to love them until the end. Because that is one of the beautiful parts of the Sacrament of Confirmation that's hiding in plain sight.



You see, we often reduce Confirmation to, "when I was a baby my parents chose this for me, but now that I'm a wise and mature teenager, I'm choosing for myself!" You don't even need to say those words out loud to realize just how silly they are; simply writing them out feels ridiculous enough, trust me. But that's how we act! And unfortunately, that's what we often tell our kids. The good news about Confirmation – well, part of it, anyway – is that when we choose God, that is actually the LEAST relevant part of the sacrament. Because there is a very big and important choice taking place in the Sacrament of Confirmation... but it is God *confirming* His choice of us! God calls us by name (Isaiah 43:1; John 10:2-3, 11; etc.), and through the sacraments we even get to hear those words spoken out loud! At every baptism, the first question the priest or deacon always asks the family is, "What name have you given your child?" Now, the priest already knows the answer, so why does he ask? Because in a few minutes, Christ Himself will speak to that child through him, call them by name, wash away their sin, and invite them into the Family of God. And what happens at Confirmation? The bishop stands before each candidate, and acting in the person of Christ, he calls each of them by name and gives them the gift of the Holy Spirit, like Jesus did for His disciples on Easter (John 20:21-22) and then again on Pentecost (Acts 2:1-4). And yes, there's an element of getting to say, "I choose you too!", but only after God smiles at us first and says, "I still love you... I will always love you... and I choose you again. Follow me."

So please pray for our teens (and while we're at it, for their parents)! May they always know how much God loves them, and experience the joy of being chosen by Him: the One who knows us best, and loves us most.
