Thank you for giving thanks to God through your generosity. Grace and peace to you, now and always.





Dear Friends,

This week we remember my two favorite saints: St. Francis of Assisi and St. Thérèse of Lisieux. They are undoubtedly among the most popular saints in Church history—Thérèse for her littleness and Francis for his love for the least among us. While these are important aspects of their lives, what draws me most to Francis and Thérèse is how they lived utterly Eucharistic lives.

For example, in response to the waning Eucharistic devotion and lax practice among many of the clergy of his time, St. Francis wrote a letter to *all priests* exhorting them to faithfully celebrate the Mass and cultivate authentic Eucharistic devotion.

St. Thérèse's "Christmas miracle," which healed her of her crippling sensitivity and self-preoccupation, occurred soon after she had received her Eucharistic Jesus during midnight Mass with her family.

Both of their lives were shaped and molded by an ever-deepening intimacy with Jesus in the Eucharist. Thérèse offered herself as a sacrifice of praise behind the walls of the Carmelite Cloister in Lisieux, France in the late 1800s. Francis preached the Gospel and served the poor in the cities of the Umbrian Valley at the dawn of the 13th century, where men and women lived like many do in our day and age: as if God didn't exist.

I am deeply indebted to Francis, who teaches me every day how to see Jesus in the Eucharist so that I may see him in the poor. Thérèse, my dear "big sister," helps me cultivate a contemplative heart in union with Jesus, our Eucharistic Love.

St. Francis and St. Thérèse, pray for us, so that, like you, we may live faithful and fruitful Eucharistic lives!




