Action Alert: SDUSD's Sexual Health Education Program (SHEP) is "too much, too soon" for children.

The Roman Catholic Diocese of San Diego believes that God loves children and doesn't want them harmed. That is why we encourage you to review the extreme Advocates for Youth (AFY) 3Rs curriculum being taught to vulnerable children in our local public schools. Please review the lessons for yourself so that you can understand the importance of this issue (especially the 6th and 8th grade lessons). According to concerned parents, here are just a few of the problems with San Diego Unified School District's graphic 3Rs program:

- **Promotes Pornography:** Curriculum links to animated videos containing pornography.
 - Kids are taught to seek information about sex on the **internet** (very dangerous).
 - Porn is highly **addictive** and extremely **destructive** to the brain (like heroin).
 - Exposure increases likelihood of **child predation, sex abuse, sex trafficking**, etc.
 - Under pressure, SDUSD removed the direct link to www.Amaze.org (i.e. Julie Melons) and a few other websites were temporarily removed. But **SDUSD is still defending porn** and plans to still use amaze.org and other porn links!
- **Not Age Appropriate/Oversexualizing:** Children as young as 11-12 yrs. old (6th grade).
- **Graphic & Promotes Taboo sex:** Detailed descriptions of **vaginal, oral, & anal sex**.
- **Dehumanizing:** Encourages kids to see other people as **sex objects** for self-gratification.
 - Not as beautiful, unique & valuable individuals in the image of God (Imago Dei).
- **Gender Blurring:** promotes transgenderism: very unhealthy lifestyle (American College of Pediatricians: "child abuse"
<https://www.acped.org/the-college-speaks/position-statements/gender-ideology-harms-children>)
 - **vs. gender binary**—we are created male & female in the image of God (Gen. 1:27).
- **Violates Freedom of Speech/Compelled Speech:** Forces students to say untruths (calling biological boys, "girls" and biological girls, "boys" / and use of pronouns).
- **Promotes Abortion:** Promotes abortion as birth control; children are told they have the right to go off campus and get abortions at Planned Parenthood, etc., w/o parents' knowledge or consent.
- **Anti-Marriage/Family:** Separates sex from marriage and doesn't really discuss or support marriage at all (in spite of the requirements of state law (Cal. Healthy Youth Act)).
 - Undermines sexual purity & abstinence—encourages pre-marital sex.
 - AFY: believes kids have "unalienable sexual rights," apart from parents and faith communities.
- **Anti-Religious:** Teaches students that religious resources about sex are "**biased**" and **unreliable**, while secular sex resources are reliable (on internet)—is hostile toward religion.

Goal: Remove and replace 3Rs w/ a curriculum that is age appropriate, medically accurate and aligns with community values.

Status: Petition on Change.org/paper: 8,000+ signatures, but we need **20,000!** Oceanside USD suspended K-6 AFY curriculum last Spring! SDUSD continues to refuse to suspend, but resistance is growing!

Asking you to:

1. **Be Informed:** www.respectculture.org (with links to the SDUSD curriculum, petition, etc.)
2. **Sign Petition:** Encourage those in your spheres of influence to sign petition.
3. **Educate Others:** Priests, parishes, minority communities, social media, etc.
4. **Opt Out:** Encourage those in your spheres of influence to **opt out** when 3Rs is taught at their school in May-June (simple written note from parent or guardian

Exposing the Anti-Mary: An Interview with Carrie Gress

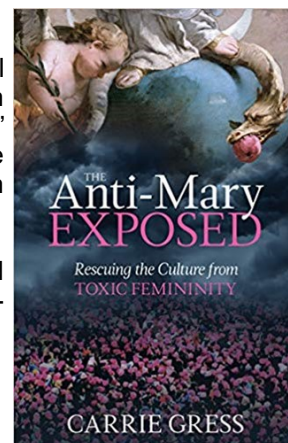
In his first epistle, the Apostle John wrote, "...as you have heard that antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come" (1 Jn. 2:19). St. Paul wrote of a final antichrist, "the man of lawlessness...the son of perdition" who will arise prior to Christ's return (2 Thess. 2:3).

The spirit of antichrist has been sowing its seeds in the world from the first century until now. In her fascinating new book, *The Anti-Mary Exposed* (TAN Books, 2019), Dr. Carrie Gress takes aim at a specific aspect of this anti-Christian spirit, one that, since the 1960s, has distorted the vision of authentic femininity found in Christian Revelation and enfolded in the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Dr. Gress marshals a mass of scholarship, presented in easily-accessible language, to detail the cultural shift brought about by a small group of elite American women. They convinced an entire generation of women that they could not be "equal" to men, could not lead "fulfilling" lives until the relationship between mother and child was disrupted. In 2019, we live with the deadly fruits of this revolution: sixty million abortions, skyrocketing divorce rates, an increase in female depression, anxiety, STDs, and substance abuse.

Gress also boldly proclaims the answer to the culture of death: Christ, Truth incarnate, and Mary, his mother and partner in redemption. It is an incredible book, and I was honored to interview Dr. Gress on behalf of *Catholic Exchange* . . .

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The second Sunday of Easter, **April 28**, is observed throughout the Church as Divine Mercy Sunday. To encourage the celebration of Divine Mercy with special devotion, Pope John Paul II established that this Sunday be enriched by a plenary indulgence (complete forgiveness of sins and punishment) which is granted to the faithful under the usual conditions: 1) Sacramental confession; 2) Eucharistic communion; 3) Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

The requirement of sacramental confession is satisfied by all who remain in the state of grace, or by regular Reconciliation available as usual, on Saturdays 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The other conditions of the plenary indulgence will be included within all celebrations of the Eucharist in this parish on Divine Mercy Sunday:

*In the *Penitential Rite* we will implore the mercy of God to be detached from all affection for sin.

*In the *General Intercessions*, we will pray for the Holy Father and his intentions and for great fidelity in our lives to works of charity and mercy, concluding with a devout prayer to our merciful Lord Jesus.

*As always we will pray together the *Creed* and the *Our Father*, that as God forgives us we will pardon those who sin against us.

Trusting in our God and His Mercy is an essential element in the celebration of this day. The feast of Divine Mercy was given by our Lord to Saint Maria Faustina. The Lord promised great graces to the faithful who fulfill all the requirements.

DIVINE MERCY NOVENA and CHAPLET

The Chaplet can be said at anytime, but the Lord specifically asked that it be recited as a novena, specially on the nine days before the Feast of Mercy. This year the 9-Day novena of Chaplets for Divine Mercy started on Good Friday, April 19.

We at Queen of Angels will begin praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet 15 minutes before each Mass on **April 27 & 28**. Please consider arriving early to join us.



The Pontifical Good Friday Collection **Providing Care to Christians in the Holy Land**



Every year on Good Friday, a collection is taken up in Catholic Churches to support the work of the Franciscans working in the Holy Land. Christians there rely heavily on the help that comes to them during this special day in the Church and our life of faith.

The Franciscan Monastery of the Holy Land in America is the home of a world-wide Commissariat of Friars Minor and monasteries who function as bridges between the Holy Land and Christians all over the world. The Commissariat offices here at the Monastery in Washington, D.C. coordinate the vital support for the work of the Franciscans who work in the Holy Land.

The Franciscans of the Custody of the Holy Land have the unique responsibility of caring for the Holy Places as well as caring for the Christians living in the Holy Land. It is vital that we care for the Christians living in the Holy Land in order to maintain a Christian presence in a land that is filled with a majority Islamic and Jewish population.

The Pontifical Good Friday Collection is applied to these programs below.

Faith, Memory & Culture – The Holy Places

Holy Land Franciscans staff and maintain the Holy places and shrines. This enables those who live in the Holy Land and those who visit to deepen their faith and their spiritual and cultural connection to Salvation history.

Social & Charitable Activities

In order to assist Christians to remain in the Holy Land, including the poor and young couples, the Custody builds thousands of residential units. Additionally, they build senior care facilities. Medical assistance is provided for the needy.

Educational & Scientific Activities

The Franciscans operate and support schools open to all, regardless of religion or nationality. They provide scholarships for students to prepare them to get jobs and remain in the Holy Land as part of living Catholic communities. Funds are distributed to young men studying to become Franciscan priests or brothers. Finally, Franciscan archaeologists pursue ongoing research at the Holy Places discovering historical artifacts.

Pastoral Activities

The Franciscans provide pastoral care in 29 parishes in the Holy Land offering Worship, Christian Formation, youth and family programs.

Liturgical, Ecumenical and Communications Programs

The Franciscan Media Center tells the story of the Holy Land through multimedia distributed throughout the world in more than seven languages. The friars organize Liturgical Celebrations for the local Christians and Pilgrims and share with other Christian communities in the Holy Land in ongoing Ecumenical cooperation.

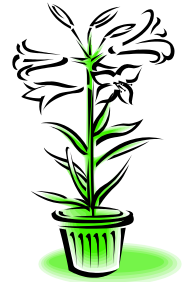

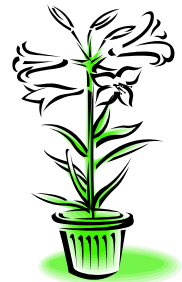
