### Christ: The Cause of Division?

Perhaps the most puzzling words Our Lord speaks in the Gospels are those we hear today: *"Do you think that I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division!"* [Lk 12:49-53] We ask ourselves 'If Jesus is called 'Prince of Peace' [Isaiah 9:6], how can He be a cause of division and strife?' So our reflection this Sunday is on how does Jesus cause division?

To answer this question we must first see Who Jesus is. His name 'Jesus' is the Greek version of the Aramaic 'Joshua', meaning Savior. This is because Jesus is the Savior of the world: He saves us from sin and death [Mt 1:21]. And what was the original cause of sin and death but the devil? The devil is the cause of sin and death whereby man lost union with God, sanctifying grace. The devil 'killed' the life of grace in man's soul, thus Our Lord calls the devil *'...the murderer from the beginning'* [Jn 8:44]. Now the devil killed the life of grace in man by division. Satan divided man's heart from God. He persuaded Adam and Eve to love themselves more than God; to be disobedient, and therefore to fall out of favor (grace) with God. So the very first "divider" or cause of division is the devil. For the devil divided man's heart away from God and toward himself. Man could no longer give himself wholeheartedly to God as a gift, and therefore was lost to loving God only half-heartedly. Mankind went from being theocentric (God-centered) to becoming anthropocentric (man-centered). Man could no longer fulfill the greatest Commandment: *"To love The Lord, your God, with all your heart, mind and soul"* [Mt 22:37]. This is the craftiness of the devil; he needs only divide man's heart in two. Half is enough for him, because he knows that man must love God with his whole heart or he does so not at all. The devil knows that if he controls even part of your heart: he has won. Perhaps this is why the devil is called *"a liar and the father of lies"* [Jn 8:44; Rev 12:9], because even a half-truth is still a lie. God knows this too, so He sent a savior, God The Son Incarnate in The Person of Jesus, to draw us back lovingly to Himself: to convert us from being 'half-hearted' to become 'whole-hearted' lovers of God.

This shines light to our question today: How does Jesus cause division? Jesus causes division because conversion of heart means that the portion of our heart given to a *disordered love of self and creatures* must be turned from the created to The Creator. There is a division that takes place because God tears our heart [Joel 2:13; Acts 2:37] away from the love of lesser, ephemeral things, to the Greatest Love: God Himself. And because *"...where your treasure is, there also will your heart be* [Mt 6:21]", the converted man no longer treasures the things – that is, the creatures – that the unconverted man treasures. In fact, the converted man is changed in motivation, vision, action, and in the whole of life, so much so that he is now called 'a new creation' [II Cor 5:17; Gal 6:15]. This causes an alienation and division from his fellow men as well [Eph 4:18], because the unconverted don't understand the converted; the disbeliever, the believer; the unspiritual man, the spiritual man [I Cor 2:14]. This because . . . *"The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not comprehended it* [Jn 1:5]." They now live by two totally different world viewpoints, for while the converted live *'in'* the world, they do not live *'of'* the world' [Jn 13:1; 15:19].

The Coming of Christ causes division because there are many people who unfortunately do not want to accept the full Word of Love and Truth [Mt 2:3, 16; 14:3]. And there are others still who are not willing to make the sacrifices necessary (*i.e.*, *the cross*) to retain that Word which they have already received, to let it grow within them [Mk 4:1]. Some even reject the truth to such an extent that they will murder the messenger of that truth, as we see of the Prophet Jeremiah in the first reading [Jer 38:4-10]. The murder of the prophets was, however, merely a prelude to the murder of Truth Itself, Our Lord Jesus, Who was put to death by the Pharisees, Scribes, and Sadducees [Jn 8:40; Mt 23:31; Acts 7:52]. It is with good reason that Our Lord told us that we would be hated merely for being His disciples, as He states in John's Gospel: *"If the world hates you, realize that it hated me first."* [Jn 15:18; I Jn 3:13]. As the secular world ascends in power we see how today Christians are hated merely for what they think. The thought-police have been unleashed against even those who would dare disagree merely in thought with the standard practical atheism of today.

On the contrary, however, Christ told us that we would be blessed when we are hated for truth's sake: *"Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude and insult you, and denounce your name as evil on account of The Son of Man. Rejoice and leap for joy on that day! Behold, your reward will be great in heaven* [Lk 6:22]". So we can see that *the real cause of division* is all those who live in falsehood, fantasy, and error; all the duplicitous, whose lives are a reaction against The Truth (Jesus); all those who do not love God wholeheartedly. Once Christ restores the whole heart of man to the love of God, the secular world despises the Christian convert because the world despises what is not its own. Our Lord makes this clear saying, *"If you belonged to the world, the world would love its own; but because you do not belong to the world, and I have chosen you out of the world, the world hates you"* [Jn 15:18].

It is within this context which we must understand the passage of the Gospel [Lk 12:49-53] spoken to us today: 'Jesus comes for division'. This is the reason why a house will be divided as Our Lord says, *"... three against two and two*

*against three; a father will be divided against his son and a son against his father, a mother against her daughter and a daughter against her mother [Lk 12:53].* Jesus restores the hearts of those who return His Love to be whole, undivided, and single-hearted. He separates the true Christian from the *disordered love of this world* [I Jn 2:16, 17], to the True Love beyond this world which is the longing for eternal bliss and happiness with Christ. This is why when a man is truly converted to The Lord he sets himself at enmity against the world, the flesh, and the devil. For, *“No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other... [Mt 6:24; Lk 16:13]”*. It is this division that causes the anxiety [II Cor 5:4] and alienation [I Peter 2:11] of the Christian in this world. *Our adolescent children especially experience this alienation within the society of our Christian families because they naturally want to enter the larger society. Children must be taught that Christianity does not forbid the use of the goods of this world, but only their abuse. This is the teaching of the moral virtues.*

To sum up: The Christian's sincere and whole-hearted conversion to Christ means that he must stand apart from the immorality of our secular world society. In the past the Christian could go his merry way because our Western Society still had some remnants of Christendom (Christian society). Now however, because of the ascendancy of practical atheism (especially since the 1960's), our society is not content to leave us alone, because when *“...wickedness is multiplied, most men's love will grow cold [Mt 24:12]”*. The Wisdom of Solomon informs us of the designs of cold, half-hearted men...

*“Let us lie in wait for the righteous man, because he is inconvenient to us and opposes our actions; he reproaches us for sins against the law, and accuses us of sins against our training. He professes to have knowledge of God, and calls himself a child of the Lord. He became to us a reproof of our thoughts; the very sight of him is a burden to us, because his manner of life is unlike that of others, and his ways are strange. We are considered by him as something base, and he avoids our ways as unclean; he calls the last end of the righteous happy, and boasts that God is his Father. Let us see if his words are true, and let us test what will happen at the end of his life; for if the righteous man is God's son, he will help him, and will deliver him from the hand of his adversaries. Let us test him with insult and torture, that we may find out how gentle he is, and make trial of his forbearance. Let us condemn him to a shameful death, for, according to what he says, he will be protected.”*

*Thus they reasoned, but they were led astray, for their wickedness blinded them, and they did not know the secret purposes of God, nor hope for the wages of holiness, nor discern the prize for blameless souls; for God created man for incorruption, and made him in the image of his own eternity, but through the devil's envy death entered the world, and his children experience it.”* (Wisdom 2:12-24)
