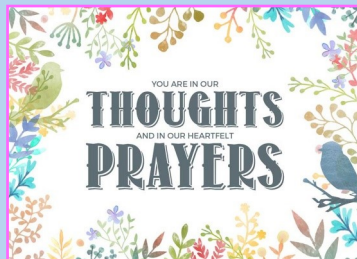

The Holy Trinity (One God – Three Divine Persons)



This is the internal life of the Most Blessed Trinity—God knowing, God known, and God-loving-and-loved. Three divine Persons, each distinct from the other two in relationship to each of the others and yet possessing one and the same divine nature, possessing that nature, too, in absolute unity. Since they possess the divine nature equally, there is no subordination of one to the other. God the Father is not wiser than God the Son. God the Son is not more powerful than God the Holy Spirit...

The three divine Persons not only are united in one divine nature; they also are united in each other. Each one of them is in each of the others in an inseparable unity—where one is, all are. This inseparable unity of the three divine Persons—in case you are interested in theological terms—is called “circumcession.”

Friends,

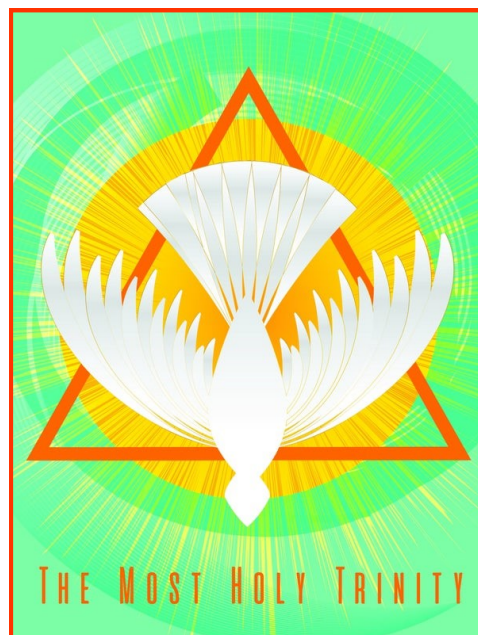
Today as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, it is good for us to remember that the mystery of the Trinity, which THE Mystery upon which all other mysteries are founded, is beyond our ability to fully comprehend. When we say that God is One *and* also Three Divine Persons, that is something that we in principle cannot understand. Every analogy, allegory, model, or whatever else we are using to try to make sense of the Trinity, will ultimately fall short, and often fail spectacularly in the attempt. But that points us to a far greater reality, that God is – thankfully, I should add – beyond us and our comprehension. I want to sit with that for a moment, if I may, while also posing the following questions: isn't it good that God is too big and too great for us to understand? Would He even still *be* God if we, in our very limited finitude, could completely understand Him and His mysterious ways? I think that many atheists miss this point, and in their well-placed desire for things to be intelligible, they imagine that anything we cannot perfectly understand must therefore be nonsense. But that simply doesn't follow logically; all it means is that our knowledge, and in this case, perhaps even our ability to fully comprehend the truth, is limited.

Saint Anselm of Canterbury defined theology as, "faith seeking understanding." This becomes especially relevant when dealing with the bigger and more inscrutable mysteries, like the Trinity. I cannot approach the mystery of the Trinity and say, "I will only believe this once it makes sense to me." I have to instead approach God, the Holy Trinity in humility and faith, saying, "I know that this mystery is beyond me; nevertheless, I believe that the Word you have spoken is true, and that someday, in your time and by your grace, I will understand."

May the Lord, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, always be with us and guide us on our search for truth. Grace and peace to you.

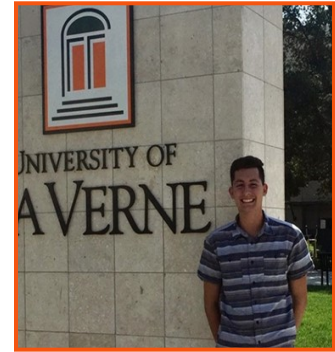

Andrew Tompkins Memorial College Scholarship Award



Andrew Joseph Tompkins was born to Diana and Paul Tompkins on Easter Sunday, April 12, 1998. He is survived by two sisters, Marion and Julia. He received the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, Holy Communion, and Confirmation at our family parish, Queen of Angels Church in Alpine, California. He was very active in our parish as a member of the children's choir, a long-time altar server, a member of the 412 Church Youth Ministry Group, and he attended the Steubenville Youth Conferences throughout his high school years.

Andrew graduated from Granite Hills High School in 2016 and attended the University of La Verne (ULV) on an academic scholarship to study business marketing. He received the Knights of Columbus scholarship award for the two years he attended ULV and was grateful to the Knights Council for the financial support. Andrew had a passion for learning. He was an Honor Student and an accomplished swimmer and diver in high school and college.

Unfortunately, Andrew was diagnosed with cancer in his second year of college and was forced to suspend his studies while he had surgery and went through chemotherapy for several months. After a very tough battle, the Lord called him home on September 22, 2019 at the age of 21. While Andrew's time at ULV was short, he completed enough units to receive his Associate of Arts degree (posthumous). He was a natural born student and loved school and university life. He would be honored to know that this scholarship fund is now named after him. Indeed, his family is honored that Andrew's memory will live on through all students who go off to college with big hopes and dreams and remain strong in the Catholic faith.

The Knight of Columbus will once again be awarding scholarships to practicing Catholics and members of Queen of Angels Parish. 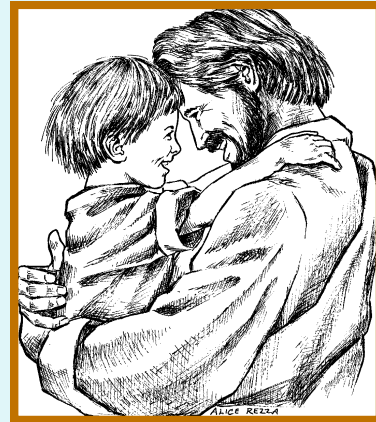
