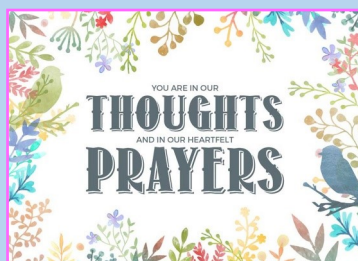

PASTOR'S PAGE

Friends,

As we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost this weekend, I would like to draw our attention to the importance, even the centrality, of proclaiming repentance and the forgiveness of sins that the Holy Spirit *immediately* sends the disciples out to do. It's striking that as soon as the Holy Spirit descends on Mary, the Apostles, and all of those in the upper room with them, that they immediately begin sharing the good news of Jesus Christ with everyone who will listen (and even some who wouldn't). While we tend to get caught up in the more obviously miraculous parts of the story – for instance, the appearance of the Holy Spirit as tongues of fire resting on them, and their sudden ability to speaking in foreign languages they don't know – perhaps the more miraculous thing is that the same people who just 53 days earlier ran away at the mere threat of being identified as the disciples of Jesus are now boldly proclaiming salvation in his name! I use the word 'striking' to describe this because it is good for us to remember that Jesus did not leave the Church behind so that we could batten down the hatches and sit out the storm outside, but so that we would be equipped to go share what we have received. This is why the final words of the Mass – "Go forth!" – are actually some of the most important we hear. We are given the gift of faith precisely so that we can *share* it.

On that note, as we consider the importance of sharing what we have freely received from God, I would like to formally invite all of you to join us in on Wednesday, June 11th, from 6:30-8:30 pm in the parish hall, for a night of evangelization training with Reggie Puertollano. Reggie is a Catholic Street Evangelist who takes with incredible seriousness the Great Commission that Jesus gave the disciples as he ascended into Heaven: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the close of the age" (cf. Mt 28:19-20). While not all of us are called to walk the streets of downtown San Diego or Las Vegas (Reggie has done both) and strike up a conversation with a complete stranger about faith, all of us do have people in our lives who need to hear how Jesus can save them and heal them, and all of us hopefully want to do a better job of communicating God's love to our family and friends. And if none of that can convince you to come, then keep in mind that Reggie is also one of my friends from before I entered the seminary, so during the Q&A period afterwards, you may be able to gather some ancient dirt on your pastor.

May the communion and fellowship of the Holy Spirit fill your hearts this Pentecost, and may all of us be flooded with God's own grace and courage so that we are unafraid to share the great gift that we have received. Happy Pentecost!

Andrew Tompkins Memorial College Scholarship Award



Andrew Joseph Tompkins was born to Diana and Paul Tompkins on Easter Sunday, April 12, 1998. He is survived by two sisters, Marion and Julia. He received the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, Holy Communion, and Confirmation at our family parish, Queen of Angels Church in Alpine, California. He was very active in our parish as a member of the children's choir, a long-time altar server, a member of the 412 Church Youth Ministry Group, and he attended the Steubenville Youth Conferences throughout his high school years.

Andrew graduated from Granite Hills High School in 2016 and attended the University of La Verne (ULV) on an academic scholarship to study business marketing. He received the Knights of Columbus scholarship award for the two years he attended ULV and was grateful to the Knights Council for the financial support. Andrew had a passion for learning. He was an Honor Student and an accomplished swimmer and diver in high school and college.

Unfortunately, Andrew was diagnosed with cancer in his second year of college and was forced to suspend his studies while he had surgery and went through chemotherapy for several months. After a very tough battle, the Lord called him home on September 22, 2019 at the age of 21. While Andrew's time at ULV was short, he completed enough units to receive his Associate of Arts degree (posthumous). He was a natural born student and loved school and university life. He would be honored to know that this scholarship fund is now named after him. Indeed, his family is honored that Andrew's memory will live on through all students who go off to college with big hopes and dreams and remain strong in the Catholic faith.

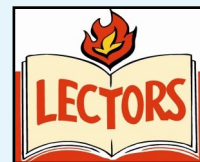
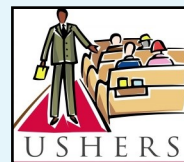

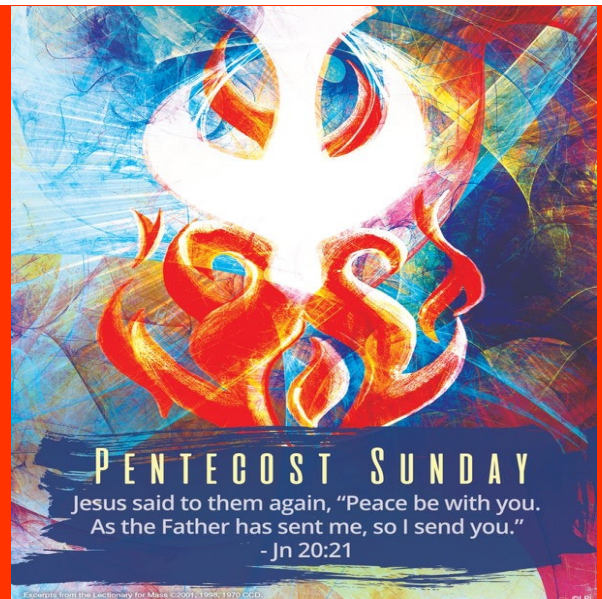
