The Indwelling of The Most Holy Trinity in The Souls of The Just

We should always note in Sacred Scripture the choice of words that Our Lord employs. For instance, upon His bodily Ascension into heaven His words are: "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of The Father, and of The Son, and of The Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age [Mt 28:18]." What is of interest here is the fact that the koine Greek is in the imperative tone, meaning a command tone. Our Lord is not suggesting that the Apostles make disciples of all nations, baptize, and teach His commandments, He is ordering them to do it! When we assent to Faith as a gift it comes with not only gifts and privileges (eternal salvation), but also responsibilities.

Today, The Feast of The Most Holy Trinity, we will speak of the greatest gift that we have received from God, which is the indwelling of the Most Holy Trinity in the souls of all the just. This gift follows upon justification through a living faith that God infuses into the souls of all His children.

Once again, we take note of the words Our Lord employs. He speaks three times of a "declaration". "He (Holy Spirit) will declare to you . . . He will glorify Me, for He will take what is Mine and declare it to you. All that The Father has is Mine; therefore . . . He will take what is Mine and declare it to you [Jn 16:12–15]." Notice that it is not merely 'He will tell you, He will inform you, He will mention to you.' No, He declares! The meaning of declare (Merriam-Webster) is: to make known formally, officially, or explicitly; to state emphatically; [from Latin declarare, from de- + clarare to make visible, from clarus, clear]. Our Lord is not merely mentioning the fact of the communication of all that is God to His Apostles, but He is formally, officially, explicitly, and emphatically declaring it to them! Thy will be done! Therefore, now that we know for certain that "All that The Father has", is communicated to His children, we should ask 'What the nature of this communication or communion?'

Basing its teaching upon sacred scripture, the Catechism [#'s 260; 265; 2781] teaches . . . "The ultimate end of the whole divine economy is the entry of God's creatures into the perfect unity of the Blessed Trinity." It goes on wondrously to teach, "But even now (on earth) we are called to be a dwelling for the Most Holy Trinity". Then, citing scripture, "If a man loves Me," says The Lord, "he will keep My word, and My Father will love him, and We will come to him, and make Our home with him [Jn 14:23]" CCC 260: (1050, 1721; 1997). Therefore, sacred scripture speaks definitively of this indwelling. Of God The Holy Spirit, "...for He (The Spirit) dwells with you, and will be in you [Jn 14:17]." Again, "...your body is a temple of The Holy Spirit within you . . . So glorify God in your body [I Co 6:19–20]". Of God The Son, "In that day you will know that I (The Son) Am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you [Jn 14:20]." And of God The Father, "If a man loves Me . . . My Father will love him, and We (Father & Son) will come to him and make Our home with him [Jn 14:23]." The most amazing thing that God gives to us is not a something, but a someONE. God gives us nothing less than His Very Self, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit!

The manner of this indwelling takes place by sanctifying grace in the soul through baptism by water and The Holy Spirit [Jn 3:5]. This grace creates us anew [II Cor 5:17] to be able – *capable* – of becoming a Temple of God. The Catechism reminds us "By the grace of Baptism 'in the name of The Father, and of The Son, and of The Holy Spirit,' we are called to share in the life of the Blessed Trinity, here on earth in the obscurity of faith, and after death in eternal light [CCC 265]". We should therefore always remember that this is God's Gift of Himself, and that, as St. Paul says, "...we have this treasure in earthen vessels, to show that the transcendent power belongs to God and not to us [II Co 4:7]". Our very Christian being, body and soul, as a Temple of God, is therefore from the fact that we contain God within our hearts, and not created things made by human hands, for again, St. Paul says, "What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will live in them... [II Co 6:15–16]". We are thus "...the household of God . . . a dwelling place of God in The Spirit [Eph 2:19–22]." This is the reason why we should always remain in a state of sanctifying grace, so that we are assured that God is indeed dwelling within us. It all depends upon our free-will choice of receiving God, either in baptism, or after a fall from grace, in a restoration of sanctifying grace in sacramental confession.

Does this Presence of God within our souls differ from the presence of God The Son, Christ Jesus, in our church altars and tabernacles? The answer is that, while Christ is substantially present in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar, God is not substantially present within our souls – otherwise we would be God! The only human Who has God substantially present in Him is The Son of God Incarnate in Jesus Christ. We say this in the Creed, that Jesus of Nazareth is 'consubstantial with The Father' and 'the Only-begotten of The Father". Rather, we have the Holy Trinity present within us, as by a likeness, through sanctifying grace. It is really God within us, but by a likeness of adoption through The Son, "...so that we might receive adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent The Spirit of His Son into our

hearts, crying, "Abba! Father! [Gal 4:4–6]". After all, if God were substantially present within us we would have to genuflect to one another in acknowledgement of that Divine Presence. We would add that, when we receive the Most Holy Eucharist in communion we do indeed receive the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Christ, and we are therefore receiving God substantially within us – if only in a temporal fashion.



A good concrete illustration of the Blessed Trinity is an equilateral triangle. Such a triangle has three sides equal in every way, and yet distinct from each other. There are three sides, but only one triangle. As we see in this illustration, each Divine


Person is different from the other two, but all three are God. Each one is God, distinct from the two others, and yet one with them. The three Persons are equal in every way, with one nature and one substance: three Divine Persons, but only one God.

In conclusion, we can say that as Christians we should meditate and contemplate upon God's indwelling within us as often as possible, that wherever we are, we are to be – to live – as a Temple of God.

"THE MYSTERY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in Himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith." The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin." CCC 234



WORLD'S TINIEST PREEMIE SHOWS ABORTION IS NOT IN LINE WITH SCIENCE

Last week the nation's imagination was captivated by a beautiful newborn baby girl called Saybie, who left the hospital weighing 5 pounds, 6 ounces. Doctors said she was born in December only 23 weeks (3 months) into her mother's pregnancy and was just about *the size of an apple*, weighing less than 9 ounces.

Her parents were told that Saybie – a name used by her care team – couldn't survive. But Saybie's parents didn't give up hope. Modern medical science saved this tiny baby's precious life and she is now thriving. The San Diego hospital where she was born said Saybie is believed to be the world's smallest surviving newborn, according to the Tiniest Babies Registry kept by the University of Iowa. I and other pro-life Americans noted on and other platforms that **Saybie is living proof that science** is on the side of the pro-life cause. Her very survival must raise questions for our nation regarding current law on abortion.

The late Supreme Court Justice Harry Blackmun famously said regarding the 1973 Roe v. Wade decision by the Supreme Court that legalized abortion nationwide: "If this suggestion of personhood is established, the appellant's case, of course, collapses, for the fetus' right to life would then be guaranteed specifically by the Amendment."

Clearly, sweet Saybie was not just a clump of cells, nor was she ever "a part of the mother's body." Saybie was and is a distinct and precious human being with intrinsic value. And of course, we are there now. Sonograms – 3-D, 4-D and HD – have settled the guestion of when life begins.

At conception, a child has his or her own DNA separate and apart from the mother.

We can see the baby's beating heart as early as 18 days.

At 30 days the developing little boy or girl has a nervous system.

At 12 weeks the child has fingernails.

At 20 weeks, the baby has all the major organs we have, along with toenails and eyebrows. The child can sleep, can hear, can respond to the mother's voice and can feel pain.

Sadly, 31 states currently allow an abortionist to take the life of other babies at the same stage in development as Saybie. Why do the lives of their children not matter? According to abortion advocates, life depends upon the state of mind of the mother – whether the child is "wanted." That's a nonsensical argument refuted by science. Planned Parenthood and the abortion industry make billions of dollars each year from scared mothers and dead babies. We are at a tipping point in our nation in which the facts can no longer be denied. Roe v. Wade is no longer in line with either science or public opinion.

People of conscience refuse to ignore the human right of a living human being to not be dismembered and discarded by a utilitarian society that finds the baby inconvenient. More and more Americans agree and are overwhelmingly rejecting the radical abortion extremism we have seen in states like Virginia and New York.

Recent pro-life legislation in states like Missouri, Alabama, Georgia, and Louisiana is partly a response to the left's rejection of truth. Americans are now in the process of setting new boundaries, given these undeniable scientific facts of human life like Saybie. **Roe v. Wade is no longer supported by science or common sense.** States will fight out their own boundaries, but one thing is certain: Saybie is living proof that **science is Pro-Life!**
