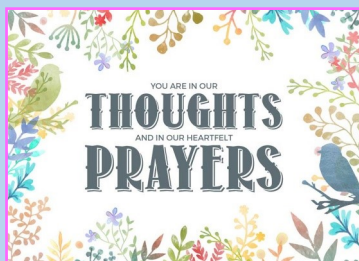

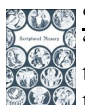

**PASTOR'S PAGE**

Friends,

As I write this, the papal conclave has not begun yet, though as you read this, it is very likely (at least if the previous two conclaves are any indication) that we already have our new pope! Or at least, I pray that is the case.

Something I would like to hold out as a humorous reminder during this time where we are called to trust in God's providence, His plan, and in His desire to work to bring all things for good, is a valuable lesson I learned many years ago as a newly ordained priest. Back then I was especially sensitive to feedback that I received on my homilies – I suspect that was at least partly due to how much feedback you get every day in the seminary compared to how little you often get day to day in the parish, particularly if you're the new guy. At any rate, I started noticing that the days that I felt really good about a certain homily were also the days that almost no one would say anything to me except for, "have a nice day, Father!" On the other hand, the days I felt like I was limping back to my chair after preaching because of how poorly I thought I had done were the days where I would get so many compliments that I wondered if people had been paying attention at all! But the best moment of all came one day, when an older gentlemen took my hand into both of his and shook it enthusiastically, all while effusively praising my homily and declaring that it was the best one I had ever given. I smiled and politely thanked him, but waited until he had left before turning to Deacon John, a huge, barrel-chested man with a white, handlebar mustache and a deep, booming voice standing next to me, and I said, "hey, Deacon John, he really enjoyed your homily today!"

It was an amazing – and hilariously humiliating – reminder of how little God actually needs me. I learned (or re-learned) a valuable lesson that day: that it's not about me, that God doesn't need me to accomplish His purpose, but also that He always makes sure that His Word bears fruit! And thank God that all of those things are true! We can pray that the Cardinals are (or as you read this, were) receptive and obedient to the Holy Spirit during the conclave, and also trust that whoever becomes the next pope will, by the grace of God, accomplish His good purpose. Hopefully our new pope will have more grace than this priest, whose best homily was apparently the one where he said nothing, but we can trust wholeheartedly that God knows what He's doing, that He loves us more than we can know, and that He always makes all things work together for good. May the Lord richly bless each and every one of you, and may he especially bless our Holy Father.

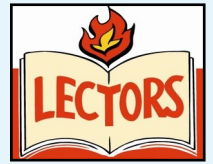

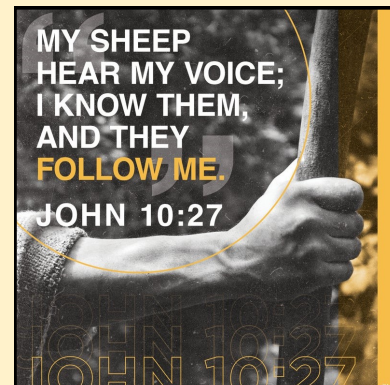
