The Peace of Christ

In the Gospel [Jn 14:23] that The Church places before us on this Sixth Sunday of Easter, we see that Our Lord speaks of The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit as *indwelling* in us. He speaks particularly of The Spirit: that when The Spirit comes this same Spirit will secure peace in the souls of all Christ's apostles and disciples. Indeed, Our Lord links the reception of the Holy Spirit with peace, when He says, "*Peace I leave with you; my peace I give unto you...*". And because the Holy Spirit is the Gift of God alone He adds, "*Not as the world gives do I give [it] peace unto you...*". It is, as He said to His Apostles in His first appearance to them after His Resurrection, "*Peace be with you. As the Father has sent Me, so I send you.*" And when He had said this, He breathed upon them and said to them, "*Receive the Holy Spirit* [20:21]." But why this union of the Holy Spirit and peace; what is their relationship?



This union of The Holy Spirit and peace follows from the fact that The Holy Spirit IS THE LOVE OF GOD. The Father loves The Son, and The Son loves The Father. This union of love between The Father and The Son is so strong that He Himself is a Person. This union of love is the Person of The Holy Spirit, Who proceeds from The Father and The Son. Who, again as we say in the Creed, "with The Father and The Son is worshipped and glorified!" So how is The Holy Spirit as the LOVE of God and the gift of Christ's peace related? The relation is that of cause and effect. Christ's peace follows upon the reception of the Holy Spirit as an effect flowing forth from its cause. This is what the CCC teaches us then: "Peace is [the work of justice and] the effect of charity #2304." Peace is *the effect of God's Love (charity)* in the human heart and soul.

True peace, that is peace of soul, is therefore not something artificial that man creates; rather, it is the gift of God which *occurs as a consequence of the Love of God* (charity) in our souls. Peace is therefore not a positive entity that exists by itself. It is an accident, a property of the substance of God's love. Just as we can say that ingesting certain substances into our body causes certain side-effects, so we can say that peace is a side-effect of love, albeit a essential one. This is why we can never 'find' peace, we can only experience peace when we are receptive to God's love. And this occurs through God's grace alone, as the Scripture says, "*...who were born not by natural generation nor by human choice nor by a man's decision but of God* [Jn 1:13]. And the reason why the love of God causes peace is that God's love conquers sin and death which is the cause of unrest and discord in the human heart. Hence, as no power of this world can forgive sins, no power of this world can cause true peace. Only God, through His Church, forgives sin and causes peace through His Holy Spirit abiding in the hearts of the just. Thus there is the peace of this world on the one hand, and the peace of God on the other, and they are at polar opposites from one another when man does not acknowledge his Creator.

This is the crucial distinction that our Lord wants us to see therefore: that the peace God grants us is not the peace the world gives. For God's peace flows from the supernatural love of God The Holy Spirit; it is an infused, internal, abiding, and transcendent peace. On the other hand, the peace the world offers us is nothing more than the mere absence of war. It is an applied, external, limited, and material peace. So theologically there is a distinction and separation in the term 'peace'. There is an external and an internal peace that differ not merely by degrees, but wholly in kind.

1.) A worldly or external peace is one that is imposed from without. This external peace is a peace that is exerted over others through violence and conflict: this peace is correlative with war. This is the peace that soldiers and armies bring about, it is a police state. It is neither interior nor lasting.

E.g. the Pax Romanum, British Empire, Napoleon, Hitler, Stalin, Mao, and all dictators who impose force and restraint from without. 2.) The divine or internal peace is one that enters the very soul of a person. This internal peace is infused into the soul, only if a person chooses God. It is a certain type of "order within the individual" caused by the love of and for God that allows the person to have a true freedom over their warring members in the body. This is the peace of Christ. The peace of Christ is an *internal peace* that one must accept. It is the Holy Spirit abiding in the heart of man.

In conclusion then, we would agree with St. Augustine who says "Peace is the tranquility of order". That is, an 'internal order' within the individual's soul; the ordered life of the virtues; justification granted to those who have a living faith in God and accept His Love as a free gift. This is why Our Lord states before all else, "*Whoever does not love Me does not keep My words...*" linking the gift of the Holy Spirit to those who follow the Commandments of virtue. This love of God that inspires the following of the Commandments grants peace to all that accept it. This peace, which results from the love of God in following the "Life of Virtue", cannot be imposed from without, but must be admitted within, or learned -- learned *experientially*. This ordered life of the virtues can be acquired to a certain extent, but not mastered without grace -- that is without the help of God. So let us accept Our Lord's distinction in the Gospel today between His peace and that of the world, as He says "... *not as the world gives do I give peace unto you.*" For true peace and fellowship flows only from the gift of God's Love, the Holy Spirit received into the hearts and souls of all those who believe in the grace of God. Let us then accept the true peace which is Our Lord gift, The Holy Spirit, The Love of God.

5:30pm mass at Newman followed by a BBQ with food, tailgating games, and bonfire.

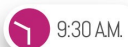

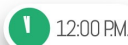
