

PASTOR'S PAGE

On The Virtue of Prudence

In the Gospel today [Lk 16:1-13] of *The Parable of the Dishonest Steward* we see how Our Lord speaks about prudence. For Jesus says "...the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light." This saying means that the unbeliever exercises more imagination and diligence in obtaining an earthly treasure than the Children of God do in obtaining a heavenly treasure. Our Lord is saying that we, as Christian disciples, should be as much, if not more, imaginative and diligent in getting to heaven, as the worldly are in obtaining passing pleasures [I Cor 9:25]. This is simply the virtue of prudence, which applies the universal principals of morality to our concrete actions. In other words for the Christian, prudence translates the theoretical Gospel into practical application in our everyday life. Hence, prudence is the first of the cardinal virtues because it is both speculative and practical reason applying morality to our human acts. We should therefore reflect upon the virtue of prudence as it is most necessary to order all the moral virtues.



The first thing that we should know is that "...it is impossible for a man to be prudent unless he be virtuous." But no sinner is a virtuous man; therefore no sinner is prudent. So how can Our Lord speak of "the children of this world" as being prudent? St Thomas speaks about three kinds of prudence. He says there is a false (or pseudo) prudence; there is an imperfect prudence; and finally, there is perfect prudence. [ST: II, II; Q 47: A 13ff: prudence in itself].

False (or pseudo) **Prudence** is in sinners alone. It takes its name – cunning – from its likeness to true prudence: for a prudent man is one who places all things well for a *good* end, whereas a cunning man is one who places all things well for an *evil* end. Thus a man is called "a good robber," and in this we way may speak of "a prudent robber," by way of similarity, because he devises fitting ways of committing robbery. This is the prudence of which St. Paul says (Romans 8:6): "The prudence of the flesh is death," because it places its ultimate end in the pleasures of the flesh. This is how Our Lord is to be understood in the Gospel today, wherefore it is not said that the children of this world are prudent absolutely, but that they are prudent – as He qualifies it – in "their generation." The mascot, if you will, of cunning is the fox, a solitary canine which hunts merely for its own purpose.

The second kind, an *Imperfect Prudence* is common to good and evil men alike. It is indeed true prudence, because it devises fitting ways of obtaining a good end; but it is imperfect because either the good which it takes for an end, *is not the common good of all human life*; or because it fails in the chief act of prudence, as when a man takes counsel aright, and forms a good judgment, *but fails to make an effective command*.

Finally there is **Perfect Prudence** which is both true and perfect, for it takes counsel, judges, and commands aright in respect of the good end of the Common Good of all men: and this alone is prudence simply so-called. Thus, taking counsel, forming good judgment, and making an effective command must all be present for one to be prudent. Hence, Perfect Prudence cannot be in sinners, but is only in the Children of God. Moreover, all persons who are made a Child of God have all the virtues – infused – by God's grace. St Thomas adds, however, that whereas all who have grace have prudence, its diligence is merely sufficient with regard to things necessary for salvation; such diligence is given by God for "The Holy Spirit's [His] unction teaches of all things" [necessary for salvation] (I Jn 2:27). This Infused Prudence by practice increases, until it becomes perfect, even as the other virtues. Hence the Apostle says (Heb 5:14) that "strong meat is for the perfect, for them who by custom have their senses exercised to the discerning of good and evil." We add too that the corresponding Gift of The Holy Spirit is The Gift of Counsel, which guides all prudence to Christian Perfection. Hence, over time, Acquired Prudence is caused by the exercise of acts, for "its acquisition demands experience and time", hence acquired prudence cannot be in the young, neither in habit nor in act. Prudence is rather in the old, not only because of their long experience but also because their natural disposition calms the movement of the emotions [sensitive passions] which disorder prudence.

Prudence is not in young people, and so should be of special concern for the young and for parents who have charge over them. Thinking about the parts of prudence: taking counsel, good judgment, and effective command, we can see that young people really have no problem with taking command themselves; they want to be independent and thus are motivated to act on their own. The real problem is in taking counsel and making good judgment. So here's a practical application.

One of the things we all know is that you can't make a good judgment unless you have the facts – that is, knowledge, the more the better. This means taking counsel, getting advice. But knowledge is power, and it is thus expensive – very expensive. When we take advice from a financial adviser we pay big bucks; coaches, teachers, professionals of any kind tell us that if you want their skills (knowledge) it's going to cost you. When you pay for an electrician, or plumber, or a surgeon, you're paying for their knowledge more than anything else. We want experience too, and of course that's going to cost you extra.



But here's the thing: when you get advice you want not only someone who knows their stuff (has been around the block a few times), you also need someone who is honest, someone who has your best interest in mind, namely, someone who loves you. After all, I can get advice from very intelligent, experienced people, but if they are evil it will be bad advice for me. So you want counsel or advice from someone who is knowledgeable, experienced, and who has your best interest in mind. It also helps if they also know you personally, so they can apply the circumstances of your life to the matter at hand. In other words, personally planned advice from someone knowledgeable and experienced, whom you know you can trust.

So, young people, who knows you best? Who loves you best? And finally who knows at least something from their own experiences? The answer is of course your parents! The very best advice that you can receive is from your parents. You never have to question whether they love you. You don't have to question whether they know you. And although they may not be rocket scientists, they do know something about life. And, given the experience of thinking through their own lives and that of their friends and family, they will not act out of passion filled emotion.

So, young people, the better part of prudence is to listen to your parents. At least weigh in the balance very heavily their advice for you. For they know you better than anyone else, they love you more than anyone else, and they have experience in life, at least 20 years more than you have. This is more than you can say about *any* of your friends, who will often advise you in their own self-interest, out of stupidity or passion filled emotion, and certainly without experience, because they have none.

And finally, this practical reflection on prudence also applies well to older parents and grandparents, really everybody because, by way of analogy, The Church is our Mother and Teacher "*Mater et Magister*"! So we should listen to Her. Because She *knows* you, She *loves* you, and, having been around for over two thousand years, She *has Great Wisdom*. So be prudent! Get counsel, judge wisely, and command yourself to act purposely upon the truth you know.

StemExpress CEO admits selling beating baby hearts, intact baby heads in Daleiden hearing

SAN FRANCISCO, California, September 6, 2019 (Abridged for brevity) Read full story at LifeSiteNews.com

A Planned Parenthood abortionist exposed in a Center for Medical Progress (CMP) undercover video as a baby body parts trafficker admitted the CMP video clips played in court Thursday were not altered.

But she made every effort to avoid admitting the videos implicated her personally in the buying or selling of human body parts, which is a federal felony.

The former director of medical services for Planned Parenthood Federation of America, identified in court as Doe 9, was a prosecution witness at the criminal preliminary hearing of CMP's David Daleiden and Sandra Merritt.

The pro-life investigative journalists are facing 15 felony charges of illegal taping of confidential information in connection with undercover videos they released in 2015 that unmasked Planned Parenthood's involvement in selling baby body parts.

Their legal team is arguing the law stipulates that conversations that can reasonably be expected to be overheard are not confidential, and that surreptitious taping of confidential information is allowed when those doing so have reason to believe they are investigating violent crimes.


Doe 9 is infamous for drinking wine and eating salad while telling Daleiden and Merritt in a covertly recorded video that, among other things, she and Planned Parenthood abortionists dismember babies in utero in such a way as to keep marketable organs intact.

"I'm not gonna crush that part. I'm gonna basically crush below, I'm gonna crush above, and I'm gonna see if I can get it all intact," she told the pair, who were posing as owners of a fetal tissue procurement firm.

Particularly as the CMP video evidence spoke for itself, defense lawyer Brentford Ferreira regarded their examination of Doe 9 as successful, even though deputy attorney general Johnette Jauron frequently objected to their questions as irrelevant, and Judge Christopher Hite tended to agree.

"With some success – the judge shut me down quite a bit – with some success, we got evidence of babies born alive and dying, and of partial-birth abortion and of changing the technique without the consent of the mother, and in a way that creates a battery on the woman," he told LifeSiteNews.

"If the only reason...to change the [abortion] technique is to get the baby parts that you want to sell to the supplier, then that is battery."

ACLU Told CA Teachers To Help Students Obtain Abortions Without Parental Notification, Video Reveals (abridged version)

A June video shows the ACLU instructing California public school teachers on how to help children obtain abortions without parental consent. The video exposes involvement by the ACLU, Planned Parenthood, and the California Board of Education. Progressive sex education programs teach children about oral and self *xes*, role-playing and more.

Video footage purportedly shows the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) instructing teachers on progressive sexual education and gender theory in collaboration with California school districts and Planned Parenthood. The video, released by conservative organization <u>Our Watch</u> and published June 26, depicts ACLU staff attorney Ruth Dawson, according to <u>Our Watch</u>, instructing teachers on how to help students obtain abortions without parental knowledge or consent. The video generated no local or national media coverage until a tipster alerted the Daily Caller News Foundation.

Dawson also instructed teachers on how to explain these students' absences to parents, how to forbid parents from opting their children out of LGBTQ education classes and more.

"They discuss gender roles, the gender spectrum, and in the support materials ... they take it even further. They discuss everything, topics like roleplaying for different genders, blood play, dental dams ... fisting is mentioned. I mean, they mention it all" said Murrieta School District parent John Andrews. "If I were to show that material to a child, I would be brought up on charges," Andrews said. "But somehow our public schools are allowed to teach this to junior high and high school kids."

<u>Our Watch</u> President Pastor Tim Thompson told the DCNF he published the video after uncovering several instances of the progressive agenda through undercover work. Thompson added that they were spurred by the California Board of Education passing legislation in May enacting compulsory sex and gender education.

The <u>Our Watch</u> president says in the video that Planned Parenthood and the ACLU collaborated on both AB329 in 2016 and the Health Education Framework in May. AB329 requires school districts to ensure students take sex-ed and encourages students to push back on sexual topics with their parents – topics explored in the kindergarten through twelfth grade sex education curricula implemented in California schools.

"We don't want our children exposed to some of these things they are showing, these pornographic, sexually explicit material. It has no place in the classroom. It's not right, and it won't be tolerated," Thompson says.
