PASTOR'S PAGE

The Gospel [Lk 14:25-33] that The Church places before us this Sunday shows us Jesus walking, *but then turning* to face the crowd following Him, as if to tell them the direction that He is going. He informs them that, in order to continue following Him as His disciples, they must be ready to deny all things (creatures) for His sake. Our Lord, in fact, uses hyperbole (*hyper-ballein*, to throw beyond) to emphasize the cost of discipleship: "*You must hate... mother, wife, children, brothers, sisters, even your own life*". He then indicates the kind of the journey when He adds, "*Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple*". Here, again, the Lord introduces the cross – to be His disciple is to enter The Way of The Cross. This talk was not popular. In fact, with this kind of talk how could Our Lord ever hope of gaining more and more disciples? This is no aberration either, if you read the Gospels you see that Our Lord's life was never about gaining popularity, in fact He runs from it, as when the people wanted to make Him king [Jn 6:15]. Jesus knew very well that His words would not be accepted by the masses [Mt 23:37]. He knew that, in the end, the majority of His own people would turn against Him, actually pleading for His death so as to release a murderer, Barabbas [Mt 23:37].



Indeed, Our Lord makes it difficult to follow Him, and yet – and here is the irony – by the beginning of the Fourth Century Christianity would become the main religion of the Roman world! Within that short time, Christianity would start to replace the pagan laws and worship of Rome. This was not despite, but particularly because, Christ manifested Himself through the cross rather than through fame and popularity. Therefore, the cross was not an accident to Christ; the cross was not an obstacle to Christ; the cross was not even a hindrance to Christ. In reality, the cross was crucial – essential – to Christ in promulgating His Good News! Our Lord makes this crystal-clear early on in His public ministry by saying "... *when I Am lifted up from the earth, I will draw all men to Myself* [Jn 12:32]". The reason for this is that "The Good News" of Jesus is nothing more than The Love of God for us made manifest. Jesus said, "*No one has greater love than this, then to lay down one's life for one's friends* [Jn 15:13]". In the end, Our Lord won over more souls by His death than He ever did by His life of public ministry! What was manifested on Calvary – on the cross – by Jesus' death was nothing less than the promulgation of His New Law of Love in His New Testament. *Our reflection then is on Christ's New Law of Love: that it is a true law, and that its promulgation is through the cross.*

This New Law of Love in Christ, written in His blood for the redemption of mankind, is the New Law of the New Testament. This New Law is a true law for it has the four essential elements that make up any just law. These are that a law must be: 1) an ordinance of right reason, 2) by the proper authority, 3) for the sake of the Common Good, which is then 4) promulgated. . . .

The New Law of Love is an ordinance of right reason, for in answering the problem of man's sin, Original and personal, it is binding upon all mankind, man, who has a rational nature that he cannot escape. For as sin is an offense against reason (CCC 1849), so the redemption would bring about a New Law that would right the wrong of reason and will, and re-order man once again to God. Hence this ordinance of truth is of a binding obligation for all men to attend to. And so Our Lord tells us, in truth, that there is no alternative...

- "...if you do not believe that I AM, you will die in your sins." [Jn 8:24].
- *Whoever believes . . . will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned.* [Mk 16:15].
- *I AM the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved...* [Jn 10:9].

I AM The Way and The Truth and The Life. [Jn 14:6]

Secondly, the New Law of Love is instituted by the proper authority, for it is wrought by The Creator Himself (*The Author*) in the very Person of God The Son, Jesus Christ, through Whom all things were made. This is the very reason that Our Lord calls us to *Himself*. There is no book, no technique, and no esoteric methodology or knowledge (gnosis) that saves us. ONLY JESUS CAN SAVE US because only Jesus is God. Hence, we see that Christ calls us to follow His very Self, to embrace His Person, the Person of God...

- Come to Me, all you who labor and are burdened... [Mt 11:28]
- I AM the light of the world. Whoever follows Me will not walk in darkness... [Jn 8:12]
- Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life.... [Jn 6:53]

I AM the Resurrection and the Life... [Jn 11:25]

Therefore the cross is an essential component of the New Law. For in reality, the crucifix is the manifestation and promulgation of the New Law of The Love of God. God loves us so much that he dies for us, and for our salvation.

The New Law of Love is for the Common Good of all peoples, for it is salvation for all mankind. Christ offers redemption for all peoples, places, cultures, races, and nations, and for all time. It is truly, as the Greeks said, "catholic", meaning universal. Again Our Lord makes this clear...

- All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations... [Mt 28:16]
- Thus it is written that... the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. [Lk 24:46]
Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature. Mk 16:15

And finally this New Law of Love in Christ would be promulgated by means of missionaries; the Apostles and Evangelists would proclaim this redemption to the entire world. Of all the world religions, *only Christianity is missionary by its very nature (truth), and from its very inception*. Our Lord makes this clear *from the beginning*...

- Jesus summoned the Twelve...and gave them authority over unclean spirits. [Mk 6:7]
- Behold, I am sending you . . . so be shrewd as serpents and simple as doves. [Mt 10:16]
- I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church . . .

All power in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of The Father, and of The Son, and of The Holy Spirit, [Mt 28:16]

The real promulgation, however, took place on Mt. Calvary on the cross itself. For all laws must be promulgated to be true law. The Old Law was promulgated by God through Moses at Mt. Sinai to the Israelites. The Old Law was written by the Finger of God on stony tablets; the New Law is written through the flesh of God in Christ, in His Own Blood, on our hearts! The New Law came to be promulgated at Mt. Calvary upon the Cross. How is that? I mean how precisely can we say that The Law of Love was promulgated on the cross? Two ways.

First the law was written out. The Jewish Religious Law (Torah) was written on the most luxurious, expensive, material – which was vellum - for the Jew this meant lamb's skin. The ink also was the most precious. Hence, God writes out His New Law of Love on lamb's skin as well, on Jesus The Lamb of God's skin! Moreover, the most precious ink was used as well – the Blood of The Lamb!

Secondly and finally, this New Law of God, written in blood on the Lamb's Skin, was promulgated. So, how was a law in the ancient world promulgated? What was done by the Ancients when they promulgated a new law was pretty much the same thing that was done in the Middle Ages, and all the way up through the 1800's in Western Civilization, and in fact even to this day. A new law is promulgated by nailing it to a post (i.e. post office)! Jesus, because He is - *in Himself* - the New Law of Love, *was nailed to a post* to be promulgated for our redemption for all to see. '*Jesus of Nazareth King of The Jews*' was written in Latin, Greek, and Hebrew for all to see [Jn 19:19]. Ecce Homo! Behold the Man!



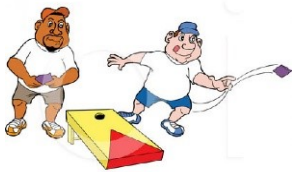
