

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Wickedness and Crime and Sin” And Moses at once bowed down to the ground in worship. [Ex 34:5-8]

Naturally speaking, God is known by His perfections just as any artist is known by his works, so the Creator can be known by His creation [Rom 1:19]. From the creation of the universe we can see that God would have certain qualities or ‘perfections’. There is what is called the *absolute perfections* of God, absolute meaning that only God can have them. The absolute perfections of God are five: 1) Self-Existence [not created]; 2) Simplicity [does not have parts]; 3) Infinity [unlimited]; 4) Eternal [always was and will be]; and 5) Immutable [does not change].

It is interesting to see that these absolute perfections of God are found in the Divine Revelation of the Old and New Testaments. For instance, in the book of Exodus [3:13]: *“But,” said Moses to God, “when I go to the Israelites and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ if they ask me, ‘What is his name?’ what am I to tell them?” God replied, “I Am Who Am.” Then He added, “This is what you shall tell the Israelites: I AM sent me to you.”* Here, God reveals Himself to Moses as the “Eternal Present”; that is, as eternal, immutable, and infinite. So we have an incidence (among many) where Divine Revelation (Faith) is 100% in compliance with nature (reason). This agrees with The Church’s official stance that faith and reason cannot contradict one another.

In addition to the absolute perfections of God, which only God can have as God, there are also what are called the relative perfections of God. Relative, meaning that these are qualities or ‘perfections’ which are manifested in His relation to creatures through analogy. So, we share in these perfections as we share in a participation with God through nature, and above all grace. Now, of the relative perfections of God, it is impossible for one to know all the perfections found in the Being of God that we participate in, however, there are chiefly five: 1) Wisdom, (e.g. Omnipotence); 2) Goodness; 3) Providence, e.g. God as Cause of all things; 4) Justice; and 5) Mercy, (e.g. Patience & Love).

Interestingly enough, again, as in the absolute perfections of God, we find in Sacred Scripture a correspondence. For instance, Our Lord tells us directly and explicitly of the importance of seeking the Creator in created things, through these perfections of God. Jesus speaks of this directly: *“Be Ye perfect as your Heavenly Father is Perfect.”* (Mt 5:48). What should be most important for the Christian is that among all these relative perfections, Our Lord Jesus singles out one – one – as the fountainhead from which flows all that comes to us in this life, and which God wishes to be praised for all eternity. This perfection is the mercy of God. Hence Jesus states: *“Be Ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is Merciful.”* (LK 6:36). This is following from the Old Testament Revelation of the Nature of God as a Being that is Mercy Itself. In The Book of Exodus it says:

Having come down in a cloud, the LORD stood with him (Moses) there and proclaimed His name, “LORD.” Thus the LORD passed before Moses and cried out, “The LORD, the LORD, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity, continuing his kindness for a thousand generations, and forgiving

So we have another incidence (among many) where Divine Revelation (Faith) is 100% in compliance with nature (reason).

In every book of the Bible – both Old and New Testaments – the Mercy of God is mentioned *repeatedly*, but most often, and most eloquently, in the Book of Psalms. In the total number of 150 Psalms there are 55 Psalms especially praising this divine perfection, and in Psalm 135 each verse repeats as its refrain, *“...for His Mercy endures forever”*. In the Bible as a whole there are over four hundred passages in which the Mercy of God is given direct praise; in the Book of Psalms, there are a hundred and thirty; and in innumerable other texts His Mercy is hymned indirectly.

In fact, in the Old Testament, God was approached through what was called the '*propitiatory*' or "*mercy seat*", which was the golden covering of *the Ark of the Covenant*, regarded as the resting place or throne of God [Heb 9:5]. In the New Testament Jesus makes mercy the very hallmark of the Christian:

"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven; for he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. For if you love those who love you, what reward have you? ...

You, therefore, must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect." [Mt 5:43ff]

We can obviously see therefore that the Mercy of God – and the mercy of the Christian – is to be extended to all people *unconditionally*, not just Christians or to those who do good for us. Finally, we see that The Church reinforces the words of Christ in the teaching that ALL CHRISTIANS are called to the height of perfection in what is referred to as the Universal call to Holiness (perfection):

"All Christians in any state or walk of life are called to the fullness of Christian life and to the perfection of charity." [*Lumen Gentium* 40] All are called to holiness: "Be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect." CCC 2013

So let us strive for the Christian perfection of charity and be merciful as our Heavenly Father is Merciful to all.

Catholic Relief Services: No Time For Accountability? March 28, 2020


After the cover-up scandals, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishop's credibility was "shredded," in the immortal words of Joliet Bishop Daniel Conlon. Every year since the bishops have made promised transparency and reform. Unfortunately, for most of those years then-Cardinal Theodore McCarrick was the USCCB's point man in this farce. McCarrick was uniquely instrumental in the operations of the U.S. hierarchy. Dozens of bishops, many of whom are still in office today, owe him their jobs. We will never know their name and number; too many high-ranking clerics in the U.S. and Rome want those facts to be buried with Mr. McCarrick. And so will the facts on Catholic Relief Services.

As the intrepid Lepanto Institute reports, McCarrick sat on the CRS board of directors for eighteen years (terms are normally limited to six years, but his colleagues made an exception for him). He also served as the chairman of CRS's Foundation board from 2006 until his sordid past was finally revealed in 2018. So now CRS joins the growing gaggle of scandalous USCCB operations that suffer from mismanagement, misrepresentation, and possible malfeasance. A class action case has been brought in federal court against the USCCB "*for its role in the fraudulent promotion of Peter's Pence as a charity to assist individuals throughout the world who have been affected by 'war, oppression, natural disaster or disease.'* Recent reports have shown as little as 10 percent of the contributions made to Peter's Pence are actually used for these stated purposes," the filing reads.

Too many questions, too few answers. It's time for the USCCB to live up to its promises. Open the books.




