

### **Keep This Handy and Refer to it as Needed**

For now we will celebrate a vigil Mass on Saturdays at 5:30pm, and one Sunday Mass at 10:30am. To proceed safely, we will need to abide by the following safety guidelines:

### HYGIENE

All parishioners above the age of 2 must wear facial covering.

The covering must be on for the duration of Mass. Please bring your own mask. Hand sanitizer will be available at all entrances and the restrooms. The church will be disinfected after each Mass. All holy water stoops will be empty. All worship aides have been removed from the pews.

### SOCIAL DISTANCING

As of today, we are limited to 100 people per Mass. This is our governor's stipulation and is subject to change. We plan to accommodate parishioners on a first come, first serve basis. Every other row will be closed and the available pews will be marked for distancing. Groups from the same household are permitted to sit together. The floor will be marked for proper distancing. The children's chapel will be unavailable for seating. No donuts. All faith formation activities are still suspended.

### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

The Sunday obligation is still dispensed. If you are in a high-risk category, or are feeling ill, you are encouraged to stay home. There will not be a collection but there will be a box for donations. Bulletins will be available but must be picked up on a table in the portico. Missals will be available in the donut room for families to take home. Personal use missals may brought to Mass but must be taken home. Please refrain from handshaking and hugging.

### LITURGY CHANGES

Mass time will be shortened to limit exposure. No Gloria, no Old Testament reading, no congregational singing, no procession of gifts, no sign of Peace. Holy Communion will be distributed under the form of consecrated bread only, and only on the hand. Please remove gloves to receive. Holy Communion will be distributed at the conclusion of Mass. To receive, maintain a six foot space, bow in reverence before the blessed sacrament, lower your mask, present your ungloved hand, consume immediately, and proceed directly to the parking lot.

### **PASTOR'S PAGE**

### God Reveals Himself Only To Those Who Humbly Accept The Darkness of Faith

Why does God hide? Why does God hide from certain people (the wise and the learned), and yet Reveal 'hidden things' only to the child-like? And finally, why does Our Lord thank The Father for these things?

First of all, God's nature is unknown or 'hidden' because God is infinitely indefinable by <u>all</u> beings, human *or angelic*. To 'define' something is to mentally circumscribe it, it is to place limits upon what a specific thing is. The word 'define' [*de fine*] means literally "to end", "to limit". The Infinite God cannot be ended or limited and therefore cannot be defined without qualification. God is the Infinite Being Who constantly *Reveals His Nature* [II Peter 1:4] to the blessed angels and saints in heaven forever! God is 'known' best therefore, not by the intellect, but by the will in a loving experience of God. Through the intellect man tries to 'package' or compartmentalize God, bringing Him down in mental terms that man can describe; through the will, however, man can ascend to the heights of God through love which unites like to like. Hence, holiness is becoming 'like' unto God through charity (love), or sanctifying grace.

Secondly, in relation to man himself, God is considered hidden because God's nature is that of a *purely Spiritual Being*. Man, as a rational animal (an animated body), can therefore only experience God, at least in this life, in a *mediated* fashion through other bodies (i.e. fire, light, sounds, even persons: Moses, Prophets, Apostles, the physical body of Christ, etc.). Man is restricted to sensate knowledge via the five senses, and as God is Pure Spirit, man cannot discern the Spirit, except through God [Jn 1:18]. Therefore we see that by *His Very Nature, in Himself, God is hidden*.

However, God manifests His hidden Nature to man in world history through Divine Revelation – Scripture and Tradition. This Revelation of His Divine Majesty is of 'The Infinite', 'The Separate', 'The Transcendent'; all of which are depicted by the understanding of indescribable, *indeterminable holiness*. Notice, it is NOT Goodness, God does not call us merely to be good, but to be holy [Lev 11:44]. In this holiness we somehow experience something of the Divine Majesty of God. Man's mental grasping of this *indeterminable holiness* is the gradual coming into the Majesty of God. That The Divine Majesty is termed 'holiness' in Sacred Scripture is clear, for The Lord, Thy God IS Holy – Holiness Itself ["Holy, Holy, Holy is The LORD of Hosts!" Isaiah 3:6; Rev 4: 8]! And *all things associated with God's Majesty must be holy too*. God's Name is holy [Pslm 30:5], The 'Holy Spirit' [Lk1:35], Holy Father [Jn 17:11], as are all His Ways [Pslm 77:12]. There are: holy things [I Chron 23:28]; holy times [Nemh 8:9]; holy places [I Chron 6:49]; holy conduct [Leviticus 19:1]; holy persons [II Kings 4:8]; and indeed, all God's people must be holy too [Lev 11:44; 20: 7], as are His holy angels [Mk 8:38]. We can see then that the majestic holiness of God is of *His Very Nature Itself*, and that to participate in God is to participate in this 'greatness of nature' [II Pet 1:4]. Man's finite nature becomes likened unto God's Infinite Nature through a participation in the holiness of God through something we call 'sanctifying grace'.

In scripture, the very desire for this participation in holiness is seen in the simile of man's effort to "Seek God's Face" [Psalm 27:7]. The psalmist especially speaks of seeking the Face of the Lord [Psalm 102: 2; 88:14; 69:17; 44:24; 30:7]; that the Face of the Lord shines brightly upon us [Psalm 4; 31:15; 44:4; 80:4; 89:16; 119:135; also, Dan 9:17; Il Sam 22:13.]; and the Face of the Lord is "Light Itself" [36 "....and in your light we see Light."]. In the Book of Revelation God is the Light Itself: "I saw ...The city had no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gave it light and its lamp was the Lamb [Rev 21:22]. Discerning the hidden nature of God, the indeterminable holiness, is like coming into the blinding light of God Who is pure spirit. Just as we need to look through a dark lens to see the sun directly, so God supplies (infuses) us in this life with a dark lens or medium as well. We call this dark lens or dark medium in this life "Faith". St. Paul said that "For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known" [I Cor 13:12]. Faith is actually the Light of God illuminating the mind which, because by nature we cannot see God, appears as darkness to the natural man, as blinding light. However, to those who are granted faith from above, it is the light of God in His Divine Mystery.

This understanding of the "God of Light" explains why Moses, who saw God face-to-Face [Num12:8], was in turn enlightened even physically: "As Moses came down from Mount Sinai . . . the skin of Moses' face had become radiant while he conversed with the Lord". [Ex 34:29]. It also explains why Jesus, in manifesting His Glory, has a radiant face at the Transfiguration on Mount Tabor: "And Jesus was transfigured before Peter, James, and John "His face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light. And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, conversing with Jesus. While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud cast a shadow over them..." [Mt 17:1-5]". How does a 'bright cloud' cast a shadow, one may ask? This overshadowing is the darkness of Faith through which we experience God [Lk 1:35; Heb 9:5, also Deut 4:11; Pslm 18:11; 97:2; I Kings 8:10].

To answer our question then; God is hidden because man, by nature, cannot see Him without the dark lenses of Supernatural Faith. Faith is the dark medium by which we can 'see' God – grasp God intellectually – in an indeterminable holiness now in this life; but one day, without faith in heaven, face-to-Face [I Cor 13:12]. Only those who are humble accept faith (excluding the wise and the learned of this world); and Jesus rejoices because The Father Revelation of Himself to the humble confounds the proud, so that the surpassing greatness (glory) is, as St. Paul says, seen as God's and not man's [I Cor 1:25-31]. Arrogant and proud men do not accept the blinding lens of dark faith for they prefer their own vision (example of stars at night). They cannot humble themselves to see the true light with the indeterminable "eyes of faith".

To sum up: we see that "The Face of The God of Light" is a burning bright radiance that no person, human or angelic, can look directly upon without being overcome and blinded by that same Light. St. Paul is our best witness to the dark medium of faith given as a gift by God. He tells us personally: "On that journey as I drew near to Damascus, about noon a great light from the sky suddenly shone around me. My companions saw the light but did not hear the voice of the one who spoke to me . . . . Since I could see nothing because of the brightness of that light, I was [blinded] led by hand by my companions and entered Damascus [Acts 22:9].

St. Paul didn't just enter Damascus that day – he entered into the "Light of Faith". We too should always pray that we will have the humility to accept the Light of Faith in a greater way every day, even if there is blindwe must be led by the hand, ultimately to see God [Acts 26:15–18].

And St. Paul said, 'Who are you, Lord!' And The Lord said, 'I AM Jesus Whom you are persecuting. But rise and stand upon your feet; for I have appeared to you for this purpose, to appoint you to serve and bear witness to the things in which you have seen Me and to those in which I will appear to you, delivering you from the people and from the Gentiles—to whom I send you to open their eyes, that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.'

### PLANNED PARENTHOOD ADMITS UNDER OATH BABIES ARE BORN ALIVE

(<u>LifeSiteNews</u>) – The pro-life investigators of the Center for Medical Progress (CMP) released a new video Tuesday containing footage from the sworn testimony of abortion industry officials admitting that they are aware of babies having been born alive, and suggesting that they are murdered soon after. In the new video, Advanced Bioscience Resources (ABR) procurement manager Perrin Larton, one of the figures featured in CMP's very first undercover videos, says that "intact" fetuses are delivered after attempted abortions "once every couple months," which is a far cry from the prevailaing abortion industry narrative that such cases are extraordinarily rare.

As to whether "intact" means a child is still alive when the procurement technician comes in to "do a dissection" for the desired tissue samples, Larton denies seeing signs of movement, but admits, "I can see hearts that are not in an intact POC [product of conception] that are beating independently."

Also testifying under oath was Dr. Deborah Nucatola, former Senior Director of Medical Services for Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA), who was also seen in the original CMP videos. Nucatola <u>became infamous</u> for admitting that Planned Parenthood is "making money off of this" despite laws against profiting from human tissue, and that abortionists know how to get around the ban on partial-birth abortion.

"I'm sure I have" had patients deliver a "nonviable fetus," she admits, meaning a "fetus that's not capable of survival." Nucatola is initially evasive about defining viability, offering that it depends on a case-by-case basis, based on many criteria, and that it "depends on where you work." She ultimately offers a few examples of factors to consider, most of which are not related to any fatal condition on the part of the baby: "estimated fetal weight, gestational age, the health of the fetus," and, notably, "the availability of interventions."

Jon Dunn, CEO of Planned Parenthood Orange & San Bernardino Counties, testifies that he can only recall one decades-old instance of a baby being delivered alive after an attempted abortion. In that case, he claims, the child was kept comfortable, and that he or she naturally died in a "matter of seconds," meaning there would not have been time to call 911 for life-saving support anyway.

"This is something that every obstetrician-gynecologist deals with on rare occasion," Dunn says. "It is their medical judgment what to do in that circumstance."

"How long will public authorities permit Planned Parenthood and their associates to sell living children inside and outside the womb and then kill them through organ harvesting?" CMP project lead David Daleiden asked. "The DOJ has vigorously prosecuted the sale of eagle body parts. Surely selling human body parts after cutting them out of an infant with a beating heart is at least as grave of a crime."

CMP's original bombshell expose of Planned Parenthood's sale of aborted babies' body parts occurred late into former President Barack Obama's second term, so naturally the abortion giant didn't have to worry about a federal investigation. Late in 2017, the Trump administration requested documents from the U.S. Senate Judiciary Committee's review of the case, which led many pro-lifers to hope Planned Parenthood would finally face justice. But no charges were ever brought.

In June 2019, 67 members of Congress <u>wrote a letter</u> to Attorney General William Barr and FBI Director Christopher Wray seeking an update on the investigation, including why no actions have been taken yet. Neither the FBI nor the Justice Department has updated the public on the state of the investigation since.
