New Public Health Order

Wednesday, November 11, San Diego County moved to the purple tier under the California governance framework regarding Covid-19. According to public health authorities, Covid-19 cases in San Diego County are growing rapidly and have again reached dangerous levels. Therefore, effective the weekend of **November 21-22**, Mass will once again be celebrated outside in the Portico with appropriate social distancing and masks required. We are asking everyone to bring their own chairs and cushions, but there will be some chairs available. Please save these for the elderly and those in most in need. You will also be allowed to sit on the stairs, and we encourage families to take advantage of this. There will be some "EZ-up" canopies for shade as well. RECOGNIZING CHRIST IN ORDER TO BE RECOGNIZED BY HIM

Christ will recognize only those who first recognized Him in the suffering and dejected of this world. Our hope of sa rests in employing our faith by being charitable to the least of our brothers and sisters.

The Church ends Her liturgical year on this **Feast of Christ The King** and begins anew next week with the First Sur Advent. And so at the end of Her liturgical year the Church reflects upon the end, the end of the world that is, an Christ will come in glory to judge the living and the dead [I Thess 4:16].

Hence, in the Gospel this Sunday [Mt 25:31-46] our Lord tells us something about Judgment Day and of those whom "le will recognize to be admitted into The Kingdom of God. This is vitally important. Many times in sacred scripture, Jesus speaks of knowing — or not knowing — those who claim to be His Own [Mt 7:23]: "... I will declare to them solemnly, 'I never knew you. Depart from Me, you evildoers'; [Lk 13:25] He will say to you in reply, 'I do not know where you are from'; [Jn 10:14] I know Mine and Mine know Me...". Indeed, in the New Testament as a whole: [I Cor 8:4] "But if one loves God, one is known by him; [I Cor 13:12] "...then I shall know fully, as I am fully known"; [Gal 4:9] "...but now that you have come to know God, or rather to be known by God..."; [II Tim 2:19] "'The Lord knows those who are His'...". Moreover, "knowledge" in the Bible is not simply knowing but it conveys the idea of a great interior intimacy. "Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, saying, "I have gotten a man with the help of the Lord." [Gen 4:1].

Of course, God being omniscient knows all His creatures, but His own are recognized not only by the Image of God, that is, a rational nature, but especially by the Likeness of God, which is supernatural grace. What The Father in heaven particularly knows and must recognize in us is above all the Likeness of His Son. The Children of Heaven must have the Image and Likeness of The Father's Son in Heaven, and not that of another [Jn 8:41-44]. When, on the Day of Judgment, we come before Christ, Jesus will look for His Likeness, which makes us to be the adopted of The Father. Only if Christ finds the likeness of supernatural grace will He know and recognize us.

The image and likeness of the Father is only in His children, and par excellence in The Father's Only Son. We see this Image and Likeness alone in its "Perfection" in the Only-Begotten Son: that God The Son is united to the human nature of Jesus Christ so intimately that to see Christ is to see The Father! [Jn 14:9]. We have nothing better to restore the image and likeness of The Father then, than to look to His Son, Jesus Christ Our Lord. Where then do we see Jesus Christ in our world today? Our Lord tells us in the Gospel today: "the hungry, the thirsty, the stranger, the naked, the ill, and the imprisoned"; in short, in the least of Christ's brothers and sisters. And note well, Our Lord does not say He is merely with them, but that He IS them, i.e. they represent Him.

Hence, only if we first recognize Christ in His suffering Body, our brothers and sisters in need, can we share with Him in the image of glory in heaven. Our Lord not only tells us this literally in the Gospel today, but He shows us this in the image of Him in heaven. What is the Image of Christ Jesus in heaven? St. John, the beloved apostle, is shown in a revelation:

Then I saw standing in the midst of the throne and the four living creatures and the elders, a Lamb that seemed to have been slain... He came and received the scroll from the right hand of the One Who sat on the throne. When He took it, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. Each of the elders held a harp and gold bowls filled with incense, which are the prayers of the holy ones. They sang a new hymn: "Worthy are you to receive the scroll and to break open its seals, for you (the Lamb) were slain and with your blood you purchased for God those from every tribe and tongue, people and nation." Rev 5:6ff

The image and likeness of Christ in heaven is that of a "Lamb that seemed to have been slain". What is a "Lamb that is slain"? It is a sacrificial victim! Christ's identity in heaven is that of a victim. Jesus identifies with all those who have become victimized for the truth, for justice, for freedom, for God. All those who are admitted into heaven will be in some way, shape, or form, a sacrificial victim! It is as our Lord says at the Sermon on the Mount:

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemakers, those who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness . . . those insulted, persecuted, and falsely reviled because of Me; for theirs is the kingdom of heaven [Mt 5:10]."

Take careful notice, it is not *all* who are victims or suffer simply, but those "...who are persecuted <u>for the sake of righteousness...reviled because of Christ [Me]</u>. This is the difference between those who suffer for their own purposes (profit), and of those who suffer for the sake of Christ Who is the Truth. They are not merely victims but sacrificial victims who offer themselves for God's purposes. *Theirs* is the kingdom of heaven.

God's likeness is therefore to be found at the very opposite pole to that imagined by the super intelligent, the powerful, and the famous. And in this discovery of the liberator in the form of a victim-slave, it is not just a matter of preparing to recognize later the unique image of God in the glorified Son. It is really a matter of a heart-to-heart recognition of the Son in his humiliated state here upon earth. To recognize Christ as glorious on the day when He will manifest Himself as such will not be enough. It will also be necessary to be recognized by Him. And on that day, only those will be recognized by Him who have recognized Jesus in the day of His humiliation in the form of a victim-slave, that is Christ in the least of our brothers and sisters. Only those will share in the glory of the Lamb who will have shared in His immolation (a death like His), in His Paschal Mystery of suffering, dying to self, and living only for Christ. These indeed will be the sheep, the righteous, who will go off to eternal life.

CALIFORNIA RESPECTS STRIP CLUBS' WHILE DISCRIMINATING AGAINST CHURCHES

In California, churches are closed for indoor services while strip clubs remain open indoors.

SAN DIEGO, California, Nov 17, 2020 (<u>LifeSiteNews</u>) — An interesting recent development in California showcases how churches are indeed being unconstitutionally discriminated against.

On November 6, 2020, the Honorable Joel R. Wohlfeil of the San Diego Superior Court issued a Temporary Restraining Order enjoining Governor Newsom and San Diego County from enforcing their COVID-19 restrictions against Pacers Showgirls. In issuing the order, the court found that the strip clubs' entertainment is "constitutionally protected speech." The court concluded that "the harm to [the strip clubs] if the Application is greater than the harm to [the government] if the Application is granted."

In contrast, <u>courts in California have refused to enjoin these same COVID-19 restrictions against houses of worship</u>. As a result, in many counties — including San Diego — churches are closed for indoor services while strip clubs remain open indoors. In other words, California courts have currently extended greater constitutional protections to strip clubs than churches.

Thomas More Society Special Counsel Paul Jonna observed, "This is a constitutional travesty that must be immediately rectified. As one California judge aptly noted — you can't treat a church like a hair salon because churches are entitled to greater protection under the Constitution. And you certainly can't treat a church like a strip club. In California, churches are being treated worse than strip clubs. The constitutional right to worship God is infinitely more important than any right to entertainment.

The Thomas More Society is currently involved in multiple California court cases on behalf of pastors, priests, and churches, and Jonna declares, "We will not rest until we fully vindicate the fundamental constitutional right to worship God without government interference."
