

Paul learned that the "thorn in his flesh" taught him to be humble and dependent upon God's grace alone. Where do you see God's grace most present in your life?


#### **GOSPEL READING**

Universities that advocate equality, discriminate against Asian-Americans in favor of African-Americans.

And, pointing out all this hypocrisy somehow makes us "racists"!


Nothing makes sense anymore, no values, no morals, no civility, and people are dying of a Chinese virus, but it is racist to refer to it as Chinese even though it began in China.

Father David Exner grew up in a Protestant home and a military family, with four younger brothers and sisters. He entered the Roman Catholic Church after college, served in the Marine Corps for five years, deploying to Iraq twice during his tenure before getting stationed at the Recruit Depot in San Diego.

He entered the seminary upon finishing his military service, completed his theological studies at the Pontifical University of Saint Thomas Aquinas while attending the North American College. Father David was ordained a priest for the Diocese of San Diego in June of 2016. He served as the Associate Pastor at Saint Michael's Catholic Church in Poway for three years, and as the Associate Pastor at Saint John of the Cross Catholic Church in Lemon Grove for two. Queen of Angels is his first assignment as a pastor, and his third assignment as a priest overall.
