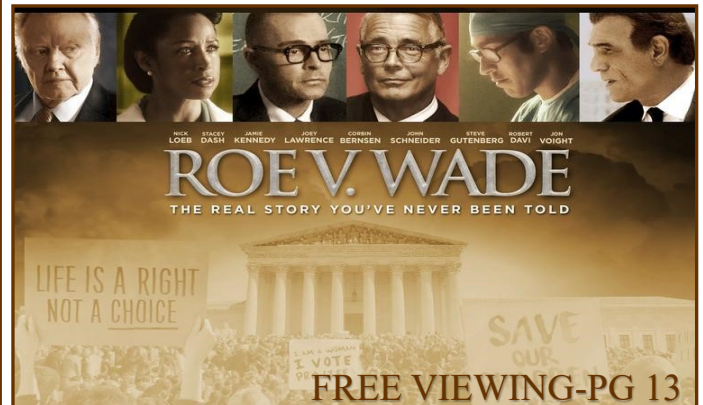

PASTOR'S PAGE

The Kingdom of God is like . . .

Is it not interesting that Jesus reveals to us by manner of parables rather than definitions. Why is that? Literally speaking, a definition is something that limits or puts a boundary around, as containing something in the mind [from Latin *definire*, from *de-* + *finire* to limit, end, from *finis* boundary, end]. A parable is, on the other hand, something that is roundabout, not strict but a vague comparison. Parable is from the Greek *paraballein* to compare, from *para-* + *ballein* to throw out; as one would “throw out” an example.



In other words, what our Lord is telling us is that The Kingdom of Heaven is not something that we can strictly define, or limit in our minds or imaginations. It is neither carnal nor venereal pleasures of the body. The Kingdom of Heaven is boundless, limitless, eternal, and infinite, and as such it defies any human definition. St. Paul says, “*What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man conceived, what God has prepared for those who love him...*” [I Cor 2:9]. Our Lord uses examples of things that are expansive and grow: the mustard seed [Mk 4:31], the new fermenting wine [Mt 9:17], the bread with yeast [Mt 13:33]. The growth is not evolutionary however, meaning that we don’t begin with one thing and end up with another thing. Rather, the Kingdom of God is *expansive and growing in an organic fashion*, whereby something becomes more of what it is from its internal structure.

As an example, there are 46 chromosomes in every cell in the human body except for the seed and egg cells (gametes) which have 23. When a baby is conceived those 46 chromosomes (½ from each parent) begin multiplying new cells. They multiply in such a way that the whole baby is always present from its conception. In other words, the baby does not grow an arm first, and then add a torso, and then legs, head, and other members; this would be Frankenstein’ish. Rather, the whole is present from the start! The baby grows larger and more definite as the weeks of gestation proceed, and hence is called a “little one” or fetus from the Latin.

It is interesting that Jesus also uses the example of the baby in the womb [Jn 16:21] to depict the Christian’s coming into the Kingdom of Heaven in his/her fullness. So the Kingdom of God is such that one is born into it, or as Jesus says to Nicodemus, “*Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born anew, he cannot see the kingdom of God* [Jn 3:3].” Entering the Kingdom by new birth in the Spirit fulfills the words of our Lord when He says that “*the Kingdom of God is within you*” [Lk 17:20].

As such, the Kingdom of God is not something that man attains, but rather something that God grants to a person “*from above*”, as a gift. This is why it is called a *spiritual birth*; it is neither here nor there in the material sense. It is a new spiritual life that, for the Christian, becomes his only life, for it is a life without end! And yet as spiritual as the Kingdom of God is, as Jesus says “*My Kingdom is not of this world* [Jn 18:36]”, nevertheless, this spiritual Kingdom *begins* here in this material world. It is in this material fallen world then that we must make the choice, the choice of what kingdom we want to live in *for eternity* – the Kingdom of this world, or the Kingdom of God.

St. Augustine (†430) wrote a famous book entitled The City of God. In it he states that every man chooses, by how he loves, of what city he wants to be a citizen of. A man either has his love in the city of God, or in the city of man. If in the City of God; he comes to love God more and more even to the point of despising the world and all its fading glory. If in the city of man; he comes to love himself more

and more, even to the point of despising God and all things spiritual. But in whatever city he chooses to live in this life, to love in this life, he also – wittingly or unwittingly –chooses the kingdom thereof in the world to come. Choose wisely, as Jesus showed us by example we can do!

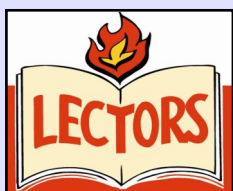

There was no escape from ideological indoctrination – anywhere.

Wokeness is becoming our new Soviet-like state religion. Careerists assert that America was always and still is a systemically racist country, without ever producing proof or a sustained argument.

The Soviets fused their press with the government.

Why do thousands now scour the internet to find any past incorrect expression of a rival? Why are there now new thought criminals supposedly guilty of climate racism, immigration racism or vaccination racism?

Soviet prosecutors and courts were weaponized according to ideology.

In America, where and for what reason you riot determines whether you face any legal consequences. Politically correct sanctuary cities defy the law with impunity. Jury members are terrified of being doxed and hunted down for an incorrect verdict. The CIA and FBI are becoming as ideological as the old KGB.

The Soviets doled out prizes on the basis of correct Soviet thought.
