VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES – SCHOOL OF RELIGION

Do you find yourself with time on your hands between 9:15 and 10:15 am on Sunday Mornings? Are you bored and blah a between 7:00pm and 8:00pm on Wednesday evenings? If so, Queen of Angels Church has a solution!

Currently, our largest Ministry is our School of Religion. We enroll an average of 120 students per year, and they are catechized by 13 volunteers. Each class also has volunteer adult and teen aides. Sometimes there are special events that also require volunteers. The following are opportunities you may consider;

Catechist – The Catechist uses the materials provided to plan lessons, and then guides the students through each lesson. Catechists also work with the DCM to resolve any special circumstances with the students.

Aide – The classroom aide typically does not have to develop the lesson plan. The aide assists with activities, may sometimes cover for the Catechist, and helps to enforce discipline in the classroom.

Office Helper - An office helper may collect attendance records and may be asked to call parents when needed. Also may run photo copies, fill out certificates, stuff envelopes etc...

Cookie Crew – Occasional meetings call for refreshments ⁽²⁾! Cookie Crew provides baked goods (or fresh fruit if we are healthy) for occasional meetings.

Reception Crew – There are a small number of receptions each year. The reception organizers shop, set up, clean up, and turn in receipts for reimbursement.

Safety Patrol – Wednesday nights can be very hectic. Safety Patrol directs traffic for drop off and pick up. They also roam the grounds to ensure all teenagers are actually in the classrooms and that there is no loitering.

Chaperones and Drivers – Sometimes a fun activity is planned off campus and the children do not drive *****. Chaperones and Drivers are needed for these occasional activities. Drivers will be required to provide proof of insurance.

Per diocesan policy, all adults who will be working with minors are required to receive Safe Environment training. The training can be done online and takes less than 30 minutes.

All teens in the Confirmation process will receive service hour credits for volunteer work.
